The charity also helps facilitate free health and dental screenings. All services are targeted towards workers and their immediate families.

The charity addresses the issues of hunger, homelessness, healthcare, and clothing for equine workers and their families. "The Tack Room" program stocks food, household and hygiene items, season appropriate clothing, and offers emergency financial aid for utilities, gas, and housing; and medical care. The charity also takes fresh fruits and perishable foods to the backstretch area of the local racetrack and training center for distribution. Two free health clinics are offered annually along with pediatric dental screenings, on-site at the racetrack.

The "Festival of Christmas" is our annual Christmas party featuring a hot dinner; new Christmas gifts and a goody bag for each child to take home; new winter, work appropriate clothing is given to all adults; and each child gets a new hat, gloves and coat. Each family receives a ham and food basket to take home. Approximately 1,000 people were served in 2011; and over 6,000 articles of clothing were given away.

Summer Camp for lower income children. Thirty-two children were chosen to participate in a week-long educational camp that included theme field trips, arts and crafts and study of life skills. Children chosen are deemed to be at-risk. The camp provides 2 meals a day; transportation, back to school supplies, and clothing.
