THESE LOANS HAVE RESULTED IN THE RECIPIENT BUSINESSES BEING ABOUT TO PRESERVE OR CREATE AN ESTIMATED APPROXIMATELY 276 JOBS AND PROVIDE VITAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING SERVICES TO AN ESTIMATED 1,960 PEOPLE TO DATE.
