CASA - A VOICE FOR CHILDREN A CALIFORNIA PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION RESTATED BYLAWS February 2011

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

Section 1 01 Purpose - CASA - A Voice for Children is organized and operated exclusively for public or charitable purposes Subject to the limitations stated in the Articles of Incorporation, the purposes of this Corporation shall be to engage in any lawful activities, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law (or any corresponding future provisions) and Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or any corresponding future provisions) The primary purpose of this Corporation shall be to establish and maintain a comprehensive program to advocate for the best interests of children who are the subject of delinquency and dependency proceedings before the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Napa

Section 1 02 Sharing Corporate Profits & Assets Prohibited - No director, officer, employee, or other person connected with this Corporation, or any private individual or entity, shall receive at any time any of the net earnings or pecuniary profit from the operations of the Corporation, provided, however, that this provision shall not prevent payment to any such person of reasonable compensation for services performed for the Corporation in achieving any of its public or charitable purposes, provided that such compensation is otherwise permitted by these bylaws and no such person or persons shall be entitled to share in the distribution of and shall not receive any of the corporate assets on dissolution or winding up of the affairs of the Corporation Upon such dissolution or winding up whether voluntarily or involuntarily the assets of the Corporation after all debts have been satisfied shall be distributed as required by the articles of incorporation of this Corporation and not otherwise

ARTICLE II OFFICES

- Section 2 01 <u>Principal Office</u> The principal office of the Corporation for the transaction of its business is located in the City of Napa, County of Napa, State of California
- Section 2 02 Other Offices The Corporation may also have offices at such other places as its business may require and as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, designate

ARTICLE III BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Section 3 01 Powers & Authority Except as otherwise expressly provided by law, the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation or these Bylaws, the activities, property and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed, supervised and controlled and all corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the direction of a Board of Directors
- Section 3 02 <u>Authorized Number</u> The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be composed of no less than three and no more than eleven individuals The number of directors may be changed by amendment of these Bylaws
- Section 3 03 <u>Election and Term of Office</u> The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by the directors at the annual meeting of the Board by a majority vote of the directors then in office, whether or not less than a quorum Each director elected thereafter shall hold office for a term of two years or until his or her successor is elected or appointed
- Section 3 04 Resignation Any director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Board of Directors or the Secretary of the Corporation Such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein, or, if no time is specified, at the time of acceptance thereof as determined by the Board of Directors If a director fails to attend three successive meetings, that director shall be deemed to have resigned from his or her position on the Board and the Board may appoint a successor to complete the term of that director No director may resign if the Corporation would then be left without a duly elected director or directors in charge of its affairs, except upon notice to the Attorney General
- Section 3 05 Removal Any director may be removed from office, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the directors at the regular annual meeting or at any special meeting called expressly for that purpose
- Section 3 06 <u>Vacancies</u> Vacancies shall be filled by majority vote of the remaining members of the Board of Directors for the unexpired term
- Section 3 07 Annual Meeting A regular annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held each year, at such time and place as shall be designated by the Board of Directors
- Section 3 08 Special Meetings Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called no less often than quarterly by the President, the Secretary or by any two of the directors then in office, to be held at such time and place as shall be designated in the notice of the meeting
- Section 3 09 Notice Notice of the time and place of any meeting of the Board of Directors shall be given at least five days prior to the meeting in the manner set forth in Section 7 01 The purpose for which a special meeting is called shall be stated in the notice Any director may waive notice of any meeting by a written statement executed either before or after the meeting Attendance and participation at a meeting without objection to notice shall also constitute a waiver of notice The transactions of any meeting of the Board of Directors, however called and noticed or wherever held, are as valid as though the meeting had been duly held after proper call and notice, provided a quorum, as hereinafter defined, is present and provided that either before or after the meeting each director not present signs a waiver of notice, a consent to holding the meeting or an approval of the minutes thereof

- Section 3 10 Quorum Except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, in the Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation or by law, no business shall be considered by the Board of Directors at any meeting at which a quorum is not present A majority of the directors then in office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board of Directors
- Section 3 11 Manner of Acting Except as otherwise expressly required by the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, these Bylaws or provisions of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law which require a greater percentage or different voting rules for approval of a matter by the Board of Directors (particularly those provisions relating to approval of contracts or transactions in which a director has a material financial interest (Section 5233) and indemnification of directors (Section 5238e), the affirmative vote of a majority of the directors present at any meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors Each director shall have one vote Voting by proxy shall not be permitted
- Section 3 12 <u>Unanimous Written Consent In Lieu of a Meeting</u> Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall unanimously consent in writing to such action For the purposes of this Section only, "all members of the board" shall not include any "interested director" as defined in Section 5233 of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law Such written consent may consist of separate documents and may be in electronic form so long as the signatures of all directors collectively appear thereon Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board Such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as the unanimous vote of the directors. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors without a meeting and that the Bylaws of this corporation authorize the directors to so act and such statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority
- Section 3 13 <u>Telecommunications Meetings</u> Any one or more directors may participate in a meeting of the Board of Directors by means of a telephone conference, electronic video screen communication or other telecommunications device which allows all persons participating in the meeting to hear one another Participation by telecommunications shall be equivalent to presence in person at the meeting for purposes of determining if a quorum is present
- Section 3 14 <u>Compensation</u> Directors shall serve without compensation, except that they may be allowed and paid their actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending the meetings of the Board of Directors
- Section 3 15 <u>Restriction Regarding Interested Directors</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of the Bylaws, not more than forty-nine percent (49%) of the persons serving on the board may be interested persons For the purposes of this section, "interested persons" means either

Any person currently being compensated by the Corporation for services rendered to it within the previous twelve (12) months, whether as a full- or part-time officer or other employee, independent contractor, or otherwise, excluding any reasonable compensation paid to a director as director, or any relative of such person

Section 3 16 <u>Conflict of Interest</u> – Any director who has a financial, personal, or official interest in, or conflict (or appearance of a conflict) with any matter pending before the Board, of such nature that it prevents or may prevent that member from acting on the matter in an impartial manner, will voluntarily excuse him/herself and will refrain from discussion and voting on said matter

Section 3 17 Members - The Corporation shall have no members Any action that would otherwise require approval by members or by a majority of members shall require approval only of the Board of Directors All rights that would otherwise vest in members under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law shall be vested in the Directors

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS

- Section 4 01 Officers The officers of the corporation shall include a President, a Secretary and a Treasurer The Board of Directors may select such other officers, including a Chairperson of the Board, as it shall deem advisable each of whom shall hold office for such period and shall have such power and perform the duties as the Board of Directors may from time to time authorize No officer other than the Chairperson of the Board need be a member of the Board of Directors The same person may concurrently hold more than one office except that neither the Secretary nor the Treasurer may concurrently serve as the President All officers shall perform their duties and exercise their powers under the ultimate direction of the Board of Directors
- Section 4 02 <u>Election of Officers</u> The officers of the Corporation shall be elected by the directors at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors
- Section 4 03 <u>Term of Office</u> The officers of the Corporation shall be installed at the annual meeting at which they are elected and shall hold office for a two-year term or until their respective successors shall have been duly elected

Section 4 04 Responsibilities of Officers

- (a) <u>Chairperson of the Board</u> The Chairperson of the Board shall preside at meetings of the Board and shall give active direction and exercise oversight pertaining to all affairs of the Corporation The Chairperson shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the Board of Directors or these Bylaws
- (b) <u>President</u> The President shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation and shall, subject to the control of the Board of Directors, supervise and control the affairs of the Corporation and the activities of the officers. The President shall perform all duties incident to his or her office and such other duties as may be required by law, by the Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation, or by these Bylaws or which may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors. The President shall possess the power to sign all certificates, contracts, or other instruments of the corporation when he or she is so authorized by the board. The President shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the Board of Directors or these Bylaws.
- (c) <u>Secretary</u> The Secretary of the Corporation shall keep or cause to be kept the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors, ensure that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws and in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors
- (d) <u>Treasurer</u> The Treasurer of the Corporation shall keep or maintain, or cause to be kept or maintained, adequate and correct books and accounts of the properties and transactions of the Corporation, and shall send or cause to be sent to the directors such financial statements and reports as are required by law or

these Bylaws to be given The books of account shall be open to inspection by any director at all reasonable times. The Treasurer shall have other powers and perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors or these Bylaws.

Section 4 05 - <u>Resignation</u> Any officer may resign at any time by giving written notice to the President or Secretary of the Corporation Such resignation shall take effect shall take effect at the time specified therein, or, if no time is specified, at the time of acceptance thereof as determined by the Board of Directors

Section 4 06 - <u>Removal</u> Subject to the rights, if any, under any contract of employment, any officer may be removed from office with or without cause by a majority vote of the directors at the regular annual meeting or at any special meeting called expressly for that purpose

Section 4 07 <u>Vacancies</u> - A vacancy in any office shall be filled by the Board of Directors for the unexpired term at the regular annual meeting or at any special meeting called expressly for that purpose

Section 4 08 <u>Compensation</u> - The salaries of the officers, if any, shall be fixed from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors and no officer shall be prevented from receiving such salary by reason of the fact that he or she is also a director of the Corporation In all cases, any salaries received by officers of this Corporation shall be reasonable and given in return for services actually rendered for the Corporation which relate to the performance of the charitable or public purposes of this Corporation

ARTICLE V COMMITTEES

Section 5 01 <u>Committees</u> - The Board of Directors may designate and appoint one or more committees as they shall deem appropriate, to serve at the pleasure of the Board Such committees shall consist of one or more directors and such other persons as the Board shall deem appropriate Such committees shall have the power and duties designated by the Board of Directors and shall give advice and make non-binding recommendations to the Board

ARTICLE VI FISCAL YEAR

Section 6.01 Fiscal Year - The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year

ARTICLE VII NOTICE

Section 7 01 Notice - Whenever under the provisions of these Bylaws notice is required to be given to a director, officer or committee, such notice shall be given in writing by personal delivery, by overnight delivery service or by first class mail with postage prepaid to such person at his or her address as it appears on the records of the Corporation Such notice shall be deemed to have been given when personally delivered or when deposited in the mail or the delivery service Notice may also be given by facsimile or electronic mail and will be deemed given upon completion of its transmission by the sending facsimile equipment or email program

ARTICLE VIII INDEMNIFICATION

Section 8 01 Non-Liability of Officers and Directors - The officers and directors of the Corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities or other obligations of the Corporation

Section 8 02 <u>Indemnification By Corporation</u> - To the extent that a person who is, or was, a director, officer, employee or other agent of this Corporation has been successful on the merits in defense of any civil, criminal, administrative or investigative proceeding brought to procure a judgment against such person by reason of the fact that he or she is, or was, an agent of the Corporation, or has been successful in defense of any claim, issue or matter, therein, such person shall be indemnified against expenses actually and reasonably incurred by the person in connection with such proceeding. If such person either settles any such claim or sustains a judgment against him or her, then indemnification against expenses, judgments, fines, settlements and other amounts reasonably incurred in connection with such proceedings shall be provided by this corporation but only to the extent allowed by, and in accordance with the requirements of, Section 5238 of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law

Section 8 03 <u>Insurance For Corporate Agents</u> - The Board of Directors may adopt a resolution authorizing the purchase and maintenance of insurance on behalf of any agent of the corporation (including a director, officer, employee or other agent of the corporation) against any liability other than for violating provisions of law relating to self-dealing (Section 5233 of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law) asserted against or incurred by the agent in such capacity or arising out of the agent's status as such, whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify the agent against such liability under the provisions of Section 5238 of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

Section 9 01 <u>Amendments</u> - These Bylaws may be amended, repealed or new Bylaws adopted upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the directors present at any meeting at which a quorum is present. The notice of the meeting shall set forth a summary of the proposed amendments
