WHEREAS, no changes made herein shall affect the Foundation's tax-exempt status described in Paragraph 8.2 of Article 8 of the Trust Agreement;

Edward Glasscock shall serve as Co-Trustee of the Foundation until the original Grantor's daughter, Alexandra Hudson Simpson, attains age eighteen (18), at which time Alexandra Hudson Simpson shall serve as Co-Trustee of the Foundation under the terms of the Trust Agreement dated December 29, 2005.
- II. Article 15, Paragraph 15.1, is hereby amended and restated so that said Article 15, Paragraph 15.1, as amended, reads in its entirety as follows:
 - 15.1 This Trust may be known as "The Glasscock-Simpson Family Foundation."
