TRANSPORTATION: The Foundation can assist with the purchase of used vehicles for individuals whose situation falls within our guidelines and where the vehicle is needed to get to and from employment (and they are presently employed full time). All used vehicles are purchased through Volunteers of America in Pontiac. The maximum amount provided is \$2500.00.

UTILITY BILLS: There is a \$500.00 limit with respect to utility related bills. Since the Foundation is a source of last resort, an applicant must first contact THAW or State Emergency Relief (SER) for assistance and we would need documentation that they have declined to help.

FURNITURE/APPLIANCES: Limited to where the individual meets the general Foundation guidelines and is moving from a domestic violence or homeless shelter situation or where furniture/appliances were destroyed by fire. Exceptions to this rule may include where the individual is working or disabled and there is a valid reason for their inability to afford the requested furniture/appliances. Unfortunately, the Foundation cannot assist in every situation where an individual moves and is in need of furniture/appliances. The Foundation has a \$750.00 limit on requests for furniture and/or appliances. All furniture/appliances are purchased through Al's Appliances and Furniture (phone number 313-526-2400). Please first submit the application to the Foundation and, if approved, an estimate will then be obtained from Al's for the requested items. The items the Foundation can approve include a bed, couch, coffee table, refrigerator, stove, dresser, kitchen table, chairs, lamps and love seat (not all items are approved for every request).

FUNDING GUIDELINES

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Grants awarded by the Here to Help Foundation arise from unsolicited requests sent to us via our on-line application form from a qualified advocate.
