Tustin Unified School District

After working closely with the Tustin Unified School District (TUSD), it was determined that it would be benefited by grants in the amount of \$7,000, which the district used for district office technology, educational supplies and equipment and educational programming to benefit TUSD. The donations helped increase transparency for all TUSD stakeholders by allowing for full immersion in technology and paperless board meetings. In addition, a \$1,000 of the grant was given for long time employee Barry Turner for an electric wheel chair. The electric wheel chair enabled teacher and coach Barry Turner to continue teaching and coaching for the remainder of the school year. (He was afflicted with ALS in 2012).

Quinnipiac University

In 2012, the Foundation again sponsored a lecture on the subject of the use of poetry in everyday life at two Tustin Unified School District high schools by Quinnipiac University English Professor and renowned author, Dr. Leonard Engle. A total of \$2,000 was paid to Quinnipiac University (QU) to help cover expenses for this event as well as to assist in covering the expenses incurred by Quinnipiac in alumni outreach while Professor Engle and other Quinnipiac staff members were in California. Plans are to repeat this visit in 2013 and to increase contributions to both these events and to Quinnipiac's Engle/Scinto Colloquium, an annual educational event held at Quinnipiac University in which QU students hold a public forum in which to present and discuss their original written works. The Colloquium gave the students better appreciation of poetry, exposed them to different types of poetry and the study of poetry ultimately helps increase/improve their interpretation skills which will aid them later on with whichever career they pursue.

Pacific Association of Pediatric Surgeons

As of November 30, 2012, a total of \$2,000 has been granted, but not yet paid, to the Pacific Association of Pediatric Surgeons (PAPS.) PAPS is an educational organization whose purpose is to train pediatric surgeons in new, life-saving surgical techniques. Due to (1) time constraints, (2) to the fact that the supported organization has not supplied sufficient verification that these funds will be used solely for charitable purposes, and (3) the scholar had become ill so the grant was postponed; no scholarships have yet been funded for impoverished third world physicians to attend educational forums and symposia conducted by PAPS.

The Foundation is both a Type I and Type II supporting organization (SO.) The Determination letter we received from the Director, Exempt Organizations of the Internal Revenue Service classified us as a Type I supporting organization under section 503(c)(3). The Foundation is a Type I by design and a Type II by its actions. While the Foundation has been approved as a Type I organization, it also functions as a Type II.

A Type II supporting organization must be "supervised or controlled in connection with" the publicly supported organizations. The Foundation meets this requirement due to the fact that some of our PSO's have appointed personnel who have a close relationship and/or a supervisory position with the PSO because their appointees are people who are either on the PSO's board and/or are in management positions of their respective PSOs.

According to both our articles and bylaws, <u>all</u> of our board members shall be people who have been selected from the specific supported organizations that we support, and all our existing board members and all of the board members are from the supported organizations that are listed in our articles. Therefore we satisfied the requirements of Regulations 1.509(a)-4(g)(1)(i). Our board members are in supervisory positions with the PSO's they represent. Therefore, the board satisfies Regulation 1.500(a)-4(h)(1) in order to be considered a Type II SO.

According to both our articles and bylaws, <u>all</u> of our board members shall be people who have been appointed by the specific supported organizations that we support, and a majority of our board members are actively involved in the supported organizations that are listed in our articles. Therefore we satisfy the requirements of both Regulations 1.509(a)-4(g)(1)(i) and 1.509(a)-4(h)(1).

We have common supervision with our foundation and our PSO's: Francine Scinto is an elected Governing Board Member of Tustin Unified School District. She is also the President of this supporting organization. This is perhaps the single most obvious and clear example of common control. Dr. Walter Chwals serves on the board of PAPS and currently holds the position of Secretary for that PSO. (He has also held various other educational positions with PAPS.)
