Single Stop USA is an innovative national program that aims to slash poverty nationwide with its highly effective "one-stop-shop" approach. Single Stop builds a bridge between low-income households and the vast untapped government resources intended for them, and maximizes the impact of these benefits with the financial education, legal services and expert counseling. The combination of resources, counseling and education is crucial to helping families move from crisis to stability, establish self-sufficiency and ultimately achieve economic mobility.

In 2011, Single Stop USA's program in community-based organizations such as food banks, neighborhood houses, health clinics and job training sites helped more than 120,000 low-income households in three states - New York, New Jersey and California- access more than \$400 million in public benefits and services, including food stamps, child care subsidies, health insurance and tax credits. Using Single Stop's web-based software, the Benefits Enrollment Network (BEN), counselors are able to let clients know in as little as 15 minutes what benefits they are likely eligible for, and then guide them through the application process. In addition, the sites offer free financial counseling, legal services and tax preparation. A recent internal analysis shows that for every dollar invested, Single Stop obtains for clients \$20 worth of benefits, tax refunds and services (based on Single Stop metrics developed by the Robin Hood Foundation). In 2011, Single Stop USA's community college program served more than 19,000 low-income students in five states - New York, New Jersey, California, Florida and New Mexico. At community colleges, Single Stop USA is replicating its model directly on campus to provide critical benefits and services that help students overcome obstacles so they can remain in school and graduate. Single Stop connected community college students to more than \$38 million in public benefits, tax refunds and other services. As part of its comprehensive service, Single Stop USA provides free tax preparation during tax season. In 2011, Single Stop tax preparers filed more than 70,000 returns that delivered more than \$126 million in tax refunds and fees avoided to low and moderate income families and individuals.
