Guidelines for Grants

AREA CODE 908 753-2440

- 1.) Grants will only be given to organizations which have received tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and qualify as "not a private foundation" under Section 509(a) of the Code; no grants will be made to individuals. If an organization has not previously received a grant from the E.J. Grassmann Trust, a copy of the organization's Section 501(c)(3) exemption letter must be submitted with the application.
- 2.) The geographic focus of the grants will be New Jersey, particularly Union County, and Georgia, primarily middle Georgia.
- 3.) Grants will be for endowment, including scholarship endowment, and capital projects. Grants will <u>not</u> be given for operating expenses, current scholarship funds or funds for attendance at conferences or workshops.
- 4.) Preference will be given to organizations with low administration expenses, that show efforts to encourage individuals to help themselves, and which make efforts to achieve a broad base of funding sources.
- 5.) The Trustees will give primary consideration to types of organizations that the benefactor of the Trust might have supported. These organizations include:
 - a.) local hospitals and health organizations;
 - b.) organizations engaged in ecological endeavors;
 - c.) educational institutions;
 - d.) organizations that help the needy, particularly children;
- 6.) Grants will be made twice a year in May and November. Grant applications must be submitted by April 20 or October 15 for each respective meeting. No grantee may receive a grant more than once per calendar year. No multi-year grants will be given.
- 7.) There is no specific application form to complete. Proposals should be in letter form, generally no more than four pages in length.
