#### LINE 1

Organizations Mission:

Development Associates International (DAI) is committed to develop the integrity and effectiveness of Christian leaders worldwide so that the church can fulfill its role in extending the Kingdom of God.

DAI is about changing lives and leadership practices, so that communities can experience the blessing and fruitfulness that comes when God's people are actively present and at work in that place. Because those goals are long term, it is important to measure and evaluate continually to see if the organization is moving toward achieving those goals. Below are the results of that measurement process. Included are the statistics of the activities and some of the ways we have ensured that those activities yielded the results our mission statement describes.

CONNECTING (creating, building and maintaining partnerships)

- DAI worked with many local and international ministries, churches and educational institutions as project partners to help them not only to find funds but also to find ways to do their own ministry better.
- Connecting 177 indigenous projects to resources needed. Part of the leadership development process is to help leaders keep growing in the way that they interact with other organizations and form partnerships. We were able to help the leadership of each of these organizations connect to resources they needed in a way that led to longer term relationships and partnerships, so that their work can continue to grow and deepen and impact others.

EDUCATING (providing relevant, formal and non-formal educational experiences)

- 10,736 leaders received extended and evaluated training enabling them to grow personally, spiritually and in their leadership roles.
- Countries where DAI workshops took place included among others: Argentina, Australia, Bangladesh, Belgium, Benin, Burundi, Bolivia, Brazil, Congo, Central African Republic, Chad, China, Columbia, D. R. Congo, Ecuador, Egypt, Haiti, Finland, Ghana, Guatamala,

Honduras, India, Indonesia, Ivory Coast, Kenya, Liberia, Middle East, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Papua New Guinea, Russia, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Sri Lanka, South Sudan, Togo, Uganda, USA and UK.

- These workshops focused on the issues leaders need, but rarely receive training in, even if they had the opportunity to attend seminary. These are the very practical issues of practicing servant leadership, team building, mentoring others, building a board of directors, growing in financial integrity, enabling women to lead, spiritual formation and strategic thinking. All of the educational tools are designed uniquely as well, being biblically based, story or case centered, extremely interactive, requiring application and encouraging relational coaching or mentoring. Transformed lives and leadership practices are the goal of those workshops and training events. We want leaders to grow both in their integrity, the "being" side of their lives, and effectiveness, the "doing" side of their lives. Many of the workshops were "Training of Trainers" workshops, done with the intent that these materials will then be taught again within the individual's sphere of influence.
- DAI coursework is available in English, French, Spanish, Portuguese, Hindi, Arabic, Russian, Kazak, Siswati, Bengali, Mandarin, and Tagalog. Certain units of portions of the curriculum are also available in Mongolian and Nepali as well as several smaller tribal languages.
- DAI courses are biblically based, interactive distance education tools, enabling Christian leaders to study where they live and work with the help of local mentors. DAI provides units of course material in a distance learning format to indigenous leaders and Christian missionaries who serve as mentors to other local leaders.
- Because of DAI's partnerships, 798 additional leaders in fourteen countries completed one year of three year MA program in Organizational Leadership. DAI continued working through established partnerships with local Universities in India, Uganda, Central Africa Republic, Burundi, Egypt, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Nigeria, Senegal, Democratic Republic of Congo and Congo-Brazziville and they were therefore able to offer this additional degree program. DAI's role is to provide the learning methodology, course content, course facilitators and technological infrastructure for this hybrid distance learning degree. Students meet for short residencies and continue working at their own pace in their various locations to complete the requirements.

CONSULTING (specialized consulting provided in areas of leadership, strategic planning, organizational structure, finance, church mobilization, and research and evaluation)

• Consulting services were provided to 291 organizations in over 20 countries (among them: India, Belgium, South Africa, Nigeria, Uganda, Ghana, Ivory Coast, Middle East, Russia, USA, Nepal, Sri Lanka, South Africa, Togo, and the UK) to serve them in areas of project management, missionary mobilization, strategic planning, financial and legal services, technology and research. DAI works with the leaders of these organizations to come alongside Christian ministries who cannot afford to purchase consulting services, to provide specific

needed expertise. This enables those organizations to function more effectively and with more results

- Building projects. One interesting project that has grown over the last few years has to do with the development of leaders so that they can build their own buildings in a cost efficient way. Because of its growth and to enable better management, it now has established its own 501(c) 3 and will be operating independently as of 2012 with minimum support from us.
- Rural development work among Himalayan peoples has taken place in cooperation with a number of small local agencies. This work includes developing younger leadership for the church in this part of the world through discipleship and training, enabling those who care for poor children and providing help in administrative systems for a number of smaller Christian entities. Training focuses on developing the leadership of children's ministries and helping to train office administrators who manage the finances. Both of these areas are some of the strongest needs in this region. Better children's ministries and more financial integrity are some of the outcomes this year.

### MENTORING (one-on-one relationships)

- 401 ongoing, long-term, mentoring relationships between DAI staff and indigenous leaders in 18 countries. Almost all of the leadership development DAI does includes mentoring. Mentoring has become a more and more valued service for some the leaders with whom DAI works. Therefore DAI models how to mentor leaders, teaches mentoring to leaders and coaches them in being mentors to others. Mentoring is a major part of ensuring that real growth takes place and that the leader continues to grow.
- Multiplication of everything DAI does is a key to long-term accomplishment of mission. All of the leaders who receive training and mentoring are encouraged to mentor others using DAI curriculum as it is useful. In ongoing evaluation, we find that the leaders who have changed and grown through their encounters with DAI programs are very consistent in passing on to others what they have learned.
