APPRAISER'S QUALIFICATIONS:

Dr. Donald Howard Cresswell has been proprietor of The Philadelphia Print Shop since 1982. Prior to owning his establishment, he was Executive Vice-President and Catalogue Editor for the firm of W. Graham Arader III in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania where he did appraisals for clients and consultations for branch offices in Philadelphia and Houston. Prior to holding that position he was Rare Book Librarian at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte. Prior to that he was Director of the Library at Belmont Abbey College, North Carolina, where he also taught an advanced course in American Intellectual History for four years in the capacity of Assistant Professor of History.

Publications include a book which was issued by The Library of Congress for its Bicentennial program Titled The American Revolution in Drawings and Prints: A Checklist of 1765-1790 Graphics in the Library of Congress (Washington: Library of Congress, 1975), it is a major reference book on prints, maps, and drawings of the American Revolution period. Also, while at The Library of Congress, Dr. Cresswell wrote for the editorial staff of A Guide to the Study of the United States of America: Supplement. Prepared under the direction of Roy P Basler and Oliver H. Orr. (Washington: Library of Congress, 1976). He has also published papers, book reviews, and given public addresses for classes and conferences. Recently he offered a course titled "A History of Cartography" at Moore College of Art in Philadelphia, and he was a visiting lecturer at The University of Pennsylvania in the Historic Preservation Program. He is a former member of the Board of Directors of The Gelman Library Friends at George Washington University in Washington. D.C and a former member of Council of the Society for the History of Discoveries. Articles and book reviews have appeared in American Maritime Prints edited by Elton Hall, American Bookman, Terra Incognita, Imprint, Imago Mundi, and Journal of the Print World. With Christopher W Lane he is author of Prints of Philadelphia from the Wohl Collection (Phila., 1990). He was a contributing author for a book issued by Abrams titled Treasures of State which includes documentation of prints and maps in the U.S. State Department Diplomatic Reception Rooms. In 1993 his shop sold to The Library of Congress its one hundred millionth acquisition which was purchased by the philanthropic organization The Madison Council. From 1997 to the present he has worked as an expert appraiser by WGBH, Boston, for appearances on the Antiques Road Show. His latest publication is a chapter on eighteenth century maps in a book, Virginia in Maps published for the Virginia State Library in Richmond. In 2005 he was elected to The American Antiquarian Society and in 2006 selected for the Board of Directors of Bartram's Garden in Philadelphia. In 2009 he was elected President of the Friends of the Academy of Natural Sciences Library.

DEFINITION OF VALUE:

The values of these prints is stated in U.S. dollars at the time of the appraisal. The amount is according to fair market value, that is, the price at which the property would change hands between a willing buyer and a willing seller, neither being under any compulsion to buy or sell and both having reasonable knowledge of relevant facts, based upon the experience of the appraiser under consideration of the importance of the works of art, condition, aesthetic appeal, and availability. The value given is for fair market as opposed to a higher value that would be given for insurance or replacement value; due to higher expenses incurred by searching and timely increases, insurance value is usually 20% higher than fair market value.

PROCEDURE FOR THE APPRAISAL:

The appraiser examined the prints, frames and portfolio at the home of Mr. Morris's mother at 2501 Pottstown Pike (PA. Route 100) in Pottstown, Pennsylvania 19465 on 15 October in the presence of Sarah Horning, an employee of Mrs. Morris. Mr. Samuel W Morris, acting in the interest of his mother and other family members asked this appraiser to provide a fair market value for the set of prints so that they will know their options for selling or donating the prints in the future.

DETERMINING A FAIR MARKET VALUE.

Values were researched in various data bases, and two were used: they were "Gordon's Print Prices 1985-Present" and "Lawrence's Dealer Print Prices 1970-2006. Gordon's records prices paid at public auctions, and Lawrence's records prices asked but not necessarily realized by dealers. Sometimes enough sales are recorded so that a strong pattern is observed to provide a value, but in this case only one set was recorded and no individual plates from the set are on record. Still, such a paucity of information illustrates that these are scarce prints.

The one recorded sale of a price realized at auction stated that on March 24, 1999 at Sotheby's in London a set pf eight colored aquatint plates of the Beaufort Hunt, with an estimate of 6,000 to 8,000 British Pounds sold for 14,950 Pounds, and at that time the exchange would have realized U.S. \$24,533. No mention is made of condition, but the large auction houses such as Sotheby's and Christie's do not place art in bad condition into their major auctions.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION:

An old but not necessarily original art buckram portfolio has a title stamped in gold, which reads, "Fox Hunting from Original Drawings by W[alter] P[arry] Hodges, Esq. and Engraved by Henry Alkin. London, 1833." Measures 31" x 22 1/2" when folded. Some mildew and dust present.

A title page reads, "A series of Eight Plates of Fox Hunting from the Original Drawings by W.P. Hodges Esq. and Engraved by Mr. Henry Alkin." / The page contains a portrait of a fox's head framed by paws and a tail and the image is hand colored. / Sub title reads, "The Sportsman's Arms."

/ "Dedicated by Special Permission to His Grace the Duke of Beaufort K.G. / London: Published by Thos. McLean 26 Haymarket Aug. 1833." 29 1/2" x 21" (sheet).

Another copy of this title page is present. This one not colored.

Dedication Page. A Crest. "To His Grace the Duke of Beaufort . . . By . . . W. P. Hodges. Dorchester. August 8, 1833. Same size as above.

Framed in various rooms in the house in Hogarth style black and gold frames are eight prints with images measuring 12 1/2" x 20 1/2". They are matted in old, acidic mats in various conditions of both prints and mats which have staining and age browning. The titles of the eight prints in the proper sequence are:

Going Out of Kennel.

Finding A Bog

Coursers Tying Up Their Dogs, Fearful of Spoiling Sport

Crossing the River Avon

The Death and the Treeing

The Return Home

Underneath the title of each is a statement, "Dedicated with Special Permission to his Grace the Duke of Beaufort K.G." The credits read, "From the Original Drawing by W. P. Hodges, Esq." and "Engraved by Henry Alken" and "T.M. McLean Direxit." The imprints read, "London Published by T.M. McLean 26 Haymarket Nov. 17, 1834" Each states "Proof Impression" at bottom left corner and "Colored by "F. Rosenberg" at bottom right

These prints are listed and described in two basic reference books on English sporting prints. See Charles Lane, Sporting Aquatints and Their Engravers I: 34 and Dudley Snelgrove comp. British Sporting and Animal Prints 1658-1874. Sport in Art and Books. The Paul Mellon Collection, p. 103.

The portfolio described here from the Morris Collection contains a ninth print which is not listed in the Lane bibliography, but it is recorded by Snelgrove as in the Mellon Collection. This plate is close to the same size as the other being 13" x 20" in the image. Along the top text reads, "Supplementary Plate" and the main title is "Consequences." The print does not have the name of the colorist, does not state, "Proof," and is dated "1834." This plate is not framed.

EVALUATION:

The primary dollar figure to consider is the \$24,533 paid for a set of eight of these prints in 1999. Factors to consider that would increase the value of these prints is the scarcity of any individual prints as well as a complete set. Most sporting prints were produced in sets of two or four, and they are difficult to find complete, so a set of eight is remarkable, and obviously a set of nine more so. Also, the Morris set has two title pages and a dedication page (nowhere else recorded). These extra assets make this an extra valuable set.

On the minus side of evaluation is the fact that all the pages and the portfolio require paper conservation. Prospective buyers of prints usually recognize that a risk factor must be considered

because conservation results are not guaranteed. This appraiser believes that conservation of this set would be successful because the quality of the original paper, inks and watercolors is obviously high. Still, and estimate of work at \$500 per 9 colored page, plus the two title pages at \$600 (\$400 + \$200), \$200 for the one dedication page, and \$400 for the portfolio is reasonable. So a total expense of \$5,700 could be expected.

The other factor which must be considered is the passage of time since the auction sale. In the same year as that sale, 1999, Paul Mellon died, and his art as part of the estate was split primarily between The National Gallery of Art in Washington and The Yale Center for British Art in New Haven. Mellon's original watercolor paintings for this set of prints went to Yale, but his prints went to the National Gallery. Yale has wanted to buy the prints ever since then but has not. This sequence of events is raised here, not to raise the value by making Yale University a Platonic client (thus violating the appraiser's definition of value above), rather it illustrates that acquisition is difficult and that the set in any condition is desirable.

Arriving at an evaluation by rounding figures it seems reasonable for an auction result of \$24,500 being raised by added elements (2 title pages and a dedication page) to \$28,000 and less conservation charges of about \$6,000 to generate a hypothetical fair market value of
