NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

December 31, 2011

1. Significant Accounting Policies

Nature of Business

The American Society for Legal History, Inc. (the "Society") was organized under the Membership Corporation Law of the State of New York in January 1959. The Society was formed for the furtherance of legal history. Said purpose includes, but is not limited to: fostering the increased study and teaching of the general history of law, providing a forum for the exchange of data and ideas, issuing publications, and the sponsoring of the occasional international congresses.

Basis of Presentation

The Society is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Unrestricted - net assets received without donor imposed stipulations. Designated net assets are those where the use restriction is determined by the organization's board.

Temporarily restricted - net assets received with donor imposed time or purpose stipulations. When the stipulated time restriction ends or purpose is met, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Permanently restricted - net assets received with donor imposed restrictions which cannot be met by either the passage of time or purpose. Investment earnings are classified based upon the donor's restrictions.

Contributions

Contributions are recorded as received and are classified as unrestricted, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted net assets depending on the existence or nature of any donor restrictions.

Contributions of donated noncash assets are recorded at their fair values in the period received.

Donated Services

Contributions of donated services that create or enhance nonfinancial assets or that require specialized skills, are provided by individuals possessing those skills, and would typically need to be purchased if not provided by donation, are recorded at their fair value in the period received.

Income Taxes

The Society was recognized as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code in October, 1972. Therefore, no provision for federal or state income taxes has been included.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

December 31, 2011

Investments

The Society carries its investments at fair value with unrealized gains and losses included in the statement of activities. Dividends and interest income are accrued as earned. Realized gains and losses are determined on a specific identification basis.

Fair Value Measurements

The Financial Accounting Standards Board established a framework for measuring the fair value of assets and liabilities. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority (Level 1) to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities and the lowest priority (Level 3) to unobservable inputs. The framework established the use of similar assets or liabilities in active markets, identical assets or liabilities in inactive markets, and observable, nonquoted prices as Level 2 in the hierarchy. As of December 31, 2011, the fair value of the Society's investments was determined using Level 1 inputs.

Functional Allocation of Expenses

Costs of providing the various programs and activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statement of activities. Certain costs may have been allocated among the programs and supporting services benefitted.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

For purposes of reporting cash flows, the Society considers all short-term highly liquid investments with maturities of three months or less, at date of acquisition, to be cash equivalents.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure on contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expense during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Subsequent Events

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States require the accounting for and disclosure of events that occur after the statement of financial position date but before financial statements are issued or are issued based available to be management's evaluation of events. Management has conducted a review of events subsequent to year end through April 26, 2012, the date the financial statements were available to be issued, and has determined that no disclosures are required.
