H&R Block, Inc. strongly believes in civic involvement and corporate responsibility. One of the ways this commitment is demonstrated is through The H & R Block Foundation Matching Gift Program. The Matching Gift Program gives eligible associates of H&R Block subsidiaries an opportunity to determine how Foundation funds are allocated and allows associates to make significantly larger charitable contributions to educational institutions

WHC MAY PARTICIPATE? Your charitable contributions may be eligible for matching if you are:

- A regular full-time employee* of H&R Block Services and its direct and indirect subsidiaries, HRB Management, Inc., and Block Financial Corporation;
- An employee who serves as a Managing Director of any other direct or indirect subsidiary.
- * A regular full-time employee of H&R Block is an associate who works five days a week, eight hours per day on a nonseasonal continuing basis.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM? Complete and sign Section 1 of the Matching Gift form. Send it, along with your gift, to the eligible educational organization you have chosen to receive your gift. The organization must complete and sign Section 2 of the form to confirm its eligibility and receipt of your gift and forward it to the Foundation. A college or university located in Canada which is listed as an institution of higher education in the most recent edition of Directory of Canadian Universities (published by the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada);

A nonprofit private or independent secondary school located in the United States or Canada which is accredited by one of the regional agencies listed above, or by an accrediting program approved by the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS); or listed as an independent or secondary school in the most recent edition of Schools Abroad of Interest to Americans, or The Handbook of Private Schools, (both published by Porter Sargent Publishers, Inc., Boston, Massachusetts) or The International Registry of Regionally Accredited Schools, (published by CORSAC) or Private Independent Schools (published by Bunting and Lyon, Inc., Wallingford, Connecticut);

For Canadian organizations, the Internal Revenue Service must recognize the recipient institution as either an organization to which contributions are tax-deductible or as a registered charity under Canada's Income Tax Act determined in good faith by The H & R Block Foundation to bean organization described in Internal Revenue Code sections 501(c)(3) or 509(a)(1), (2), or (3).



How do I know if my organization is eligible to receive a grant from the Foundation?

To request a grant, your organization must be a federally tax-exempt, section 501(c)(3) chantable organization, a school, a library, or a public agency

My 501(c)(3) has a pending status; do I qualify to receive a donation?

No The Foundation does not fund organizations with a pending 501(c)(3) status. Only organizations that are verified with a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) designation, as determined by the Internal Revenue Service, are eligible to receive donations.

What types of projects are most likely to receive support?

The Foundation prefers to support projects and programs that strive for excellence, improve service for clients and strengthen the organization. A major emphasis is placed on support of activities that serve underserved, low-income persons living in Jackson, Clay, and Platte counties in Missouri, and Wyandotte and Johnson counties in Kansas.

What types of organizations are not funded through The H & R Block Foundation?

The H & R Block Foundation generally does not make grants to

- Organizations that are not in compliance with laws and regulations that govern them
- . Individuals or businesses
- Publications
- Projects for which the Foundation must exercise expenditure responsibility
- Single-disease causes
- # Travel or conferences
- Historic preservation
- n Telethons, dinners, advertising, sponsorships, or other special events
- Animal-related causes
- Sports-related causes

What is the general duration of grants made by the Foundation?

The Foundation usually makes one-year grants. However, in appropriate circumstances, the Foundation will consider requests for up to 5 years.

How much money can my organization apply for?

The Foundation does not have a minimum or maximum grant amount. Grants amounts are determined based upon the total cost of the program or project. Last year, our average grant size was \$20,000

When do you accept proposals?

Applications are available year-around. Proposals are reviewed four times a year, in conjunction with the Foundation's Board of Directors meetings. Please see the box on the right hand side of the Nonprofit Organization tab for a list of grant deadlines.

Can I get a copy of the online application form?

You will be able to print a copy as you are filling out the online application form. Click on the Printer Friendly Version link located in the top right hand corner of each application page.

Do I have to complete the application in one online session?

No, you can start the application and choose to save and finish it at another time. Just click on the "Save and Finish Later" button located at the bottom of each application page.

Is my application automatically saved once I create an account?

No, your application is not saved automatically. To ensure no application data is lost, please click on the "Save and Finish Later" button at the bottom of each application page.
