AUDIT COMMITTEE OF THE STATE COUNCIL WAS TERMINATED.

NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS:

THE PROCESS FOR SELECTING VICE PRESIDENT'S TO THE PA AFL-CIO SHALL BE DETERMINED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD.

COUNCIL FEES:

MONTHLY DUES SHALL BE ONE DOLLAR AND THIRTY-FIVE CENTS(\$1.35) PER MEMBER
PER MONTH. BY MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD, THE STATE COUNCIL CAN PERMIT A
