The role of Kleinheinz Family Endowment for the Arts and Education is to focus attention on important charitable issues and institutions. This can best be done by encouraging both new and established non-profit organizations to develop new programs which address these issues or to expand existing programs which fill gaps in the existing programs. Categories considered for funding include, but are not limited to:

- Arts and Cultural Affairs
- Education
- Community Program and Service

Applications are not accepted for grants to individuals.

The enclosed outline should be used to prepare a grant application. Applications should be brief but complete enough to explain the project. When an application is received, it will be reviewed for thoroughness and the receipt acknowledged. Kleinheinz Family Endowment for the Arts and Education may request a meeting with the proposer to discuss the application.

The Board of Directors meets in June and November to review all completed applications which meet grant guidelines. Deadlines for applications are June 1 and November 1, as applicable. Applicants should not contact members of the Board to discuss proposals. All applicants will be notified as soon as a decision is made concerning their request. Each application is given individualized attention and the review process is flexible enough to meet needs as they emerge.

- 2. Grant Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation's Board of Directors in June and November, when funding priorities will be established.
- 3. Grants will be distributed in July and December.
- 4. A report of the use of funds and effectiveness of the project should be submitted to the Foundation forty-five days after the funds are expended.
