On November 21, 2011, the Estate of Eleanor R. King (EIN 26-6455841), with the approval of the Board of The Lloyd J. King and Eleanor R. King Foundation, sold its largest remaining asset, approximately 33 acres of land, for \$9,479,500. The proceeds, plus additional cash totalling \$9,740,000 were transferred to The Lloyd J.
