|      | Health and Education for Haiti's first major program area is medical missions. During 2011, we conducted seven one-week  |
|      | medical missions to the Grande-Anse Department of Haiti and treated approximately 7,000 patients. Our volunteer doctors and  |
|      | nurses donated over 4,000 hours seeing patients. The volunteers paid all of their travel costs to and from the city of Jeremie   |
|      | Our volunteers diagnosed each patient and provided them with medications to treat their conditions. We also made 522 referrals   |
|      | for people with serious or chronic conditions to other providers and paid all of the expenses for their care, including a small  |
|      | travel stipend based on their distance from the provider Of those 522 referrals, 75 people were referred to Port-au-Prince or other  |
|      | major location for serious conditions that could not be treated in the Jeremie area. We provided funds to these individuals so they  |
|      | could travel and pay for their medical care  |

|      | Health and Education for Haiti's second major program area is education. During 2011, we provided several grants that enabled  |
|      | us to assist over 1,700 students to attend primary or secondary school. Grants totaled \$11,498 to assist over 320 individual students with tuition payments. These students were identified by the Regional Education and Development Programme (PRED), a |
|      | division of Caritas International. All funds were paid either to PRED or directly to the schools for the student's tuition. In addition,   |
|      | Health and Education for Haiti also subsidizes teacher salaries to reduce the overall cost of schooling to make it less expensive  |
|      | for all Grants of \$36,503 were paid directly to 3 schools to cover significant portions of teacher salaries. Over 1,400 students  |
|      | attend these three schools St. Paul's Parish School (Grades 1-12, over 700 students), Heart of Jesus School (Grades 1-6, over 550  |
|      | students), and College Notre Dame (Grades 7-12, Over 150 students) benefited from these grants with significantly reduced  |
|      | education costs College Notre Dame is the only secondary school within a 15 mile radius, so it is an enabler for these students who  |
|      | otherwise wouldn't attend secondary school. We also provided grants of \$7,259 to expand the secondary school building at St   |
|      | Paul's Parish School, and \$3,000 to make repairs at Heart of Jesus School Health and Education for Haiti provided \$245 in school   |
|      | supplies for St. Pauls Parish School. We also provided a grant of \$2,000 for an Agronomy program at College Notre Dame  |

|      | This has become additionally important due to the recurring outbreaks of cholera. We provided a grant of \$5,000 for 200 water filters   |
|      | to be distributed by PRED to families in the Leon area. We also provided a grant to St Paul's parish to continue the satellite   |
|      | communications that are critical for St Paul's and PRED to operate efficiently. Additionally, we provided a grant of a multi-function  |
|      | printer/scanner to the regional hospital in Anse d'Hainault to enable them to more effectively manage patient records. Health and  |
|      | Education for Haiti also contributed to a water survey for the Carcasse parish to identify sources of water and the testing supplies   |
