Clarifications regarding Part VII-B Questions:

1a(6): The Helen Coburn Meier and Tim Meier Charitable Foundation for the Arts ("Foundation") did not intentionally agree to pay money or property to a government official during the year. The Meiers originally had hired Michele E. Smith ("Ms. Smith") in 2009 as a personal assistant to help them manage the Foundation's books and records, assess art and artists, provide publicity and media relations, and give strategic guidance to the Foundation on an as-needed basis. Because Ms. Smith was providing services to the Foundation, the Foundation's accountant recommended that the Foundation pay her directly and take the compensation as a Foundation expense. Later, in 2011, Ms. Smith was elected as an alderman for the City of Chicago. Neither Ms. Smith, the Foundation directors, nor their accountants were aware that this made Ms. Smith a "government official" and barred her from receiving compensation from the Foundation. In early 2015 the Foundation and Ms. Smith became aware that payments to Ms. Smith, even for her personal services to the Foundation entirely outside of her scope of governmental work, were considered an act of self-dealing since she was an alderman for the City of Chicago which made her a government official. Immediately upon discovering that this was an act of self-dealing, Ms. Smith resigned as a director and returned all of her compensation received from the Foundation for all years. She received no further compensation once she determined it was self-dealing.

Since Ms. Smith returned all of her compensation from the Foundation and received no further compensation once she became aware that it was self-dealing, the Foundation believes there should not be any imposition of tax caused by these acts. For this reason, the Foundation is not filing Form 4720.

1b: As explained above, the Foundation ceased payments to Ms. Smith as soon as the became aware it was self-dealing, so the Foundation believes it was not violating an rules and does not need to qualify for an exception.

1c: As explained above, the Foundation immediately ceased payments to Ms. Smith once found out it was considered self-dealing, so it immediately corrected the act once it became a problem.

Amendment to Part VIII, 3:

As explained in Statement 1, upon the Foundation's accountant's recommendation, the Foundation had paid Ms. Smith as an independent contractor for her services in managing the Foundation's books and records, assessing art and artists, providing publicity and media relations, and giving strategic guidance to the Foundation on an as-needed basis. She was paid \$72,000 during 2011. However, Ms. Smith has returned to the Foundation all of her payments from 2011.

Answers to Part XV, Questions 2a-d:

- 2a: Applications Addressed to Whom: The Foundation does not accept applications from artists for the awards. The Foundation receives nominations from a group of individuals interested in the art world. The board of nominators began as a group of non-artists, but now is made up of previous Foundation award winners who all are very active in various aspects of the art world.
- 2b: Form of Application: As explained above, the Foundation does not accept applications, so there is no form and no materials to submit. The board of nominators comes up with artists to consider and submits a list to the board of directors. The board of directors then views artists' works on line and in person without letting the artist know he or she is being considered for the award. After reviewing the artists' works, the board of directors votes on the awards.
- 2c: Deadlines: As explained above, there are no submissions allowed, so there are no deadlines.
- 2d: Restrictions on Awards: The awards are given to Chicago-area artists in music, theater, visual arts, literature and dance who are in mid-career and have demonstrated both talent and persistence in pursuing their craft. Special emphasis is placed on overlooked or under publicized talent who are "pushing the envelope," that is, continuing to innovate, as well as community involvement.
