Under section 7508A, the IRS gives affected taxpayers until February 1, 2013 to file most tax returns (including individual, corporate, and estate and trust income tax returns; partnership returns, S corporation returns, and trust returns; estate, gift, and generation-skipping transfer tax returns; and employment and certain excise tax returns), or to make tax payments, including estimated tax payments, that have either an original or extended due date occurring on or after October 26, 2012 and on or before February 1, 2013.
