SL offers a high quality thrift shopping experience in a clean, organized retail environment with a focus on providing excellent customer service to encourage repeat business and word-of-mouth promotion.

Proceeds from the sale of donated items are used to support store expenses and to issue monetary grants to various animal shelters to support the mission of reducing euthanasia of adoptable pets and finding homes for homeless pets. Grant recipient organizations are exempt under Section 501(c(3) of the code.
