CVS CAREMARK CORPORATION ("CVS") ESTABLISHED THE CVS CAREMARK EMPLOYEE RELIEF FUND ("ERF") TO INITIATE A "RELIEF" PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYEES IN NEED. FUNDRAISING FOR THE ERF WILL COME FROM CVS EMPLOYEES MAKING VOLUNTARY DONATIONS. ADDITIONALLY, IN 2010 CVS MADE A CONTRIBUTION OF \$300,000. IN 2011, CVS MADE A CONTRIBUTION \$138,926. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT ALL OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS WILL COUNT AS VALID PUBLIC SUPPORT, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 98% OF THE \$300,000 CONTRIBUTIONS FROM CVS IN 2010 AND 98% OF THE \$138,926 CONTRIBUTIONS MADE FROM CVS IN 2011.
