AMENDED AND RESTATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

\mathbf{OF}

WISHARD MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned officer of Wishard Memorial Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation"), pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Nonprofit Corporation Act of 1991, as amended (the "Act"), hereby executes the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (the "Articles"), which supersede and take the place of the previously existing articles of the Foundation and all provisions and amendments thereto:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Foundation is Eskenazi Health Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Purposes

Section 1. This Foundation is a public benefit corporation that shall be organized and operated exclusively to benefit, perform the functions of, and carry out the exclusively charitable, scientific, educational, and other purposes of The Health and Hospital Corporation of Marion County (the "Supported Organization"), to the extent that such purposes are described in Sections 170(c)(2)(B), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws (the "Code").

Section 2. In carrying out such charitable, scientific, educational, and other purposes, and subject thereto, the Foundation shall engage in activities including, but not limited to, the following:

- a. The raising, holding, administering, and expending of funds to support programs of health care and health services in Marion County;
- b. The operation of health programs and the provision of patient care services;
- c. The promotion of public awareness and education regarding health services, health needs, and public responsibilities;

- d. The administration of trust funds, bequests, devises, and gifts to the Public Health Department, the Board of Health of Indianapolis, the Supported Organization (including organizations doing business under the names of the William N. Wishard Memorial Hospital (eventually doing business under the name of Sidney and Lois Eskenazi Hospital), Wishard Health Services (eventually doing business under the name of Eskenazi Health), or other organizations under the purview of the Supported Organization), or for the benefit of the poor and the sick of Indianapolis or other generally named beneficiaries, the responsibilities for the health care of whom rests with health agencies of local government in Marion County, Indiana, such as, but not limited to, organizations described in this section, or such other named beneficiaries relating to publicly owned local health institutions, agencies, and departments in Indianapolis and Marion County, Indiana, their predecessors, and successors;
- e. The support of the charitable, educational, and scientific programs of the Supported Organization and Indiana University School of Medicine; and
- f. Other lawful activities not otherwise prohibited that further and support the Foundation's stated goals and purposes.

ARTICLE III

Powers

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, neither the Board of Directors nor the Foundation shall have the power or authority to do any act that will prevent the Foundation from being an organization described in Code sections 170(c)(2)(B), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2). Subject to the foregoing statement, and subject to and in furtherance of the purposes for which it is organized, the Foundation shall possess, in addition to the general rights, privileges, and powers conferred by the Act or by other law, the following rights, privileges, and powers:

Section 1. To indemnify any person against liability and expenses, and to advance the expenses incurred by such person, in connection with the defense of any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, investigative, or otherwise, and whether formal or informal, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, or, if not permitted, then to any extent not prohibited by such law.

Section 2. To cease its activities and to dissolve and surrender its corporate franchise.

ARTICLE IV

Period of Existence

The period during which the Foundation shall continue is perpetual.

ARTICLE V

Registered Agent and Registered Office

Section 1. At the time of filing these Articles, the name and address of the registered agent in charge of the Foundation's registered office is Julie L. Rowlas, Eskenazi Health Foundation, Inc., 1001 West 10th Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46202.

Section 2. At the time of filing these Articles, the street address of the registered office of the Foundation is 1001 West 10th Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46202.

ARTICLE VI

Members

The Foundation shall not have members as defined in the Act. The Foundation may, however, identify as "members" classes of individuals who are supportive of Foundation purposes, participate in Foundation programs, pay dues, and/or satisfy other criteria established by the Board of Directors. Such designation shall carry no legal significance and shall not entitle classes or individuals to any vote on Foundation matters or to attendance at any Foundation meetings.

ARTICLE VII

Directors

The exact number of directors of the Foundation shall be specified in or fixed in accordance with the Bylaws of the Foundation (the "Bylaws") at a number no smaller than three (3).

ARTICLE VIII

Designation, Election, or Appointment of Directors

The directors of the Foundation shall be designated, elected, or appointed in the manner and for terms specified in or fixed in accordance with the Bylaws of the Foundation; provided, however, that at all times a majority of the directors shall be persons designated or appointed by the Supported Organization.

ARTICLE IX

No Private Inurement

None of the Foundation's net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE X

Regulation of Corporate Affairs

The affairs of the Foundation shall be subject to the following provisions:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, if for any taxable year the Foundation is deemed a "private foundation" described in Code section 509(a), the Foundation's income shall be distributed at such time and in such manner as not to subject the Foundation to the tax imposed by Code section 4942.

- Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, if at any time the Foundation is deemed a "private foundation" described in Code section 509(a), the Foundation shall not:
 - a. Engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Code section 4941(d);
 - b. Retain any excess business holdings as defined in Code section 4943(c);
 - c. Make any investment in such manner as to subject the Foundation to tax under Code section 4944; or
 - d. Make any taxable expenditure as defined in Code section 4945(d).

Section 3. Neither the Board of Directors nor the Foundation shall have power or authority to do any act that will prevent the Foundation from being an organization described in Code section 501(c)(3).

- Section 4. Except as otherwise permitted by Code section 501(h), no substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall be or consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- Section 5. The Foundation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- Section 6. Subject to the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation and applicable law, the Board of Directors shall have complete and plenary power to manage, control, and conduct all the affairs of the Foundation.
- Section 7. The power to make, alter, amend, and repeal the Foundation's Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors.
- Section 8. No director or member of the Foundation shall be liable for any of its obligations.
- <u>Section 9</u>. Meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at any location, either inside the State of Indiana or elsewhere.
- Section 10. All parties dealing with the Foundation shall have the right to rely upon any action taken by the Foundation pursuant to authorization by the Board of Directors by resolution duly adopted in accordance with the Foundation's Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and applicable law.
- Section 11. The Board of Directors may from time to time, in the Bylaws of the Foundation or by resolution, designate such committees as the Board of Directors may deem desirable for the furtherance of the purposes of the Foundation.

ARTICLE XI

Dissolution of the Foundation

If the Foundation is dissolved, all of its property remaining after payment and discharge of its obligations shall be transferred and conveyed, subject to any contractual or legal requirement, first, as donors of property to the Foundation may have directed at the time of their gifts to the Foundation. In the event that no such donor directions or restrictions exist for the property of the Foundation, then the property shall be distributed to the Supported Organization. If at the time of the Foundation's dissolution, the Supported Organization is not a governmental unit or instrumentality of the State as described in Code sections 170(b)(1)(A)(v) and 170(c)(1), and is not described as an organization in Code sections 170(c)(2)(B), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2), the Foundation shall not distribute property to the Supported Organization; if the Supported Organization does not qualify to receive property upon dissolution, the Foundation shall distribute such property to one or more organizations designated by the Board of Directors that are organized and operated for purposes substantially the same as those of the Foundation, and that are described in Code sections 170(c)(2)(B), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2).

ARTICLE XII

Amendment

The power to amend or alter these Articles shall be vested in the Board of Directors of the Foundation; provided however, that the amendment of these Articles shall require the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Board of Directors then in office, unless the Act requires a greater vote.

The undersigned officer of the Foundation hereby presents these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation to the Secretary of State of the State of Indiana for filing, and states that the manner of their adoption and the vote by which they were adopted constitute full legal compliance with the provisions of the Act, the previously existing articles of the Foundation, and the Bylaws of the Foundation.
