The candidate was comprehensively interviewed by the Committee. The process also allowed for the opportunity for each member of the Board of Directors to interview the selected candidate. Both the candidate and his compensation were approved by the full Board of Directors at a Board meeting. His compensation thereafter is subject to annual salary increases and limited bonuses subject to discussion and approval by the Board of Directors.

#### Part III - 1: STATEMENT 1: ORGANIZATION'S MISSION

Provide compassionate service through food and assistance programs to individuals, families and children in need to instill dignity and break the cycle of dependence.

Part III - 4a: STATEMENT 2: FOOD CENTER

The Organization provides hot meals to the hungry and poor, including meals to qualified homebound individuals, principally seniors; grocery items to qualified low-income individuals and families; and meals on weekends to children who qualify in local public schools. During 2011, the Organization prepared and served more than 45,000 hot meals and distributed over 22,000 grocery food bags to the working poor, unemployed, disabled, homebound and homeless; prepared and handed out more than 34,000 sandwiches to those less fortunate in the community, principally children in low-income area after school programs; and recovered more than 800,000 pounds of food from supermarkets, restaurants, individuals, businesses, governmental agencies and other organizations.

Part III - 4b: STATEMENT 3: RESOURCE CENTER

During 2011, the Organization provided approximately \$123,000 in temporary, limited financial assistance to qualified residents of Boca Raton to alleviate crisis situations by paying bills, principally directly to landlords and utility companies. Qualified individuals and families were also offered referrals to other agencies. The Organization also provided underprivileged school age children with various school needs, such as uniforms, supplies and funds for summer camps.

Part III – 4c: STATEMENT 4: JOB MENTORING PROGRAM

The Organization provides job mentoring assistance to job seekers such as resume preparation, interview training and computer and life skill classes. During 2011, the Organization's Job Mentoring Program resulted in more than 100 individuals obtaining employment.
