The Patient Assistance Program (BI-PAP) is a critical program in fulfilling the Foundation's mission to improve the lives of patients through philanthropic contributions and donations of our products and resources. Through the BI-PAP, BI Cares provides selected pharmaceutical products free of charge to qualified individuals. BI Cares employs a professional management company (Vendor) to administer the BI-PAP in full compliance with all applicable legal and regulatory laws and regulations, including but not limited to FDA requirements, Federal Trade Commission and Prescription Drug Marketing Act (PDMA), OIG guidance, as well as state and federal patient privacy and fraud and abuse laws.

The BI-PAP serves eligible patients who have been prescribed pharmaceutical products that are manufactured and/or distributed by the Boehringer Ingelheim Group. Persons seeking assistance in the form of free prescription pharmaceutical products may apply to the BI-PAP for assistance. The application will include relevant medical information from the patient's physician, a valid prescription from the physician for a product distributed through the BI-PAP, and financial information supporting their eligibility for the BI-PAP. The application will be submitted to the Vendor for review and processing.

Products are made available to patients eligible for the BI-PAP based on objective program and financial criteria. The application must be completed in full in order to be considered for approval by the Vendor. If a patient is approved to participate in the BI-PAP, prescribed product will be dispensed to the patient through appropriate channels approved by the Foundation. Once accepted into the BI-PAP, the patient continues to receive the pharmaceutical support for as long as he/she continues to qualify for the program, but must reapply to the program each year.

All specific references to the identity of patients applying for and/or participating in the BI-PAP are maintained in strict confidence by the Vendor and are not disclosed to BI Cares or any other persons without the prior written consent of the patient.

The provision of high-quality health care requires the exchange of personal, often sensitive information between a patient and a skilled health care practitioner. Vital to that interaction is the patient's ability to trust that the information shared will be protected and kept confidential. However, in the unlikely event that BI Cares obtains access to such information, it is used for limited eligibility assessment/health care operations purposed contemplated by HIPAA. The Patient Authorization Form signed as part of the application packet will expressly authorize the limited and appropriate use of PHI by our vendor and BI in the processing of their application. The Patient Authorization Form must be a separate and fully self-contained document.

A. INTRODUCTION AND PHILOSOPHY:

In order to be considered, the application must be completed in its entirety. Information requested includes, but is not limited to, information about the nonprofit organization, its operating budget and an executive summary of the program for which funding is sought.

Semi-annually, the Foundation Steering Committee will approve or deny the charitable donation requests received and determine the distribution of Foundation charitable funds.

C. GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANT APPROVAL:

BI Cares is a tax-exempt private operating foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"). The Foundation reserves the right to limit financial contributions to nonprofit organizations with programs that meet the following criteria, as determined within the sole discretion of the Foundation:

- 1. A proposed program must align with the mission and goals of the Foundation.
- 2. The following types of tax-exempt organizations and/or programs are among those eligible for receiving charitable contribution from BI Cares:
 - Access to healthcare
 - Math or science education
 - Disaster relief
 - Philanthropic activities in our medical therapeutic categories
 - Community programs benefitting our identified areas of interest
- 3. The following are guidelines for reviewing and approving a specific charitable donation request:
 - Consistency with the policies of the Foundation.
 - Extent of community need for the program or organization's services.
 - The impact of the program as identified in the proposal and stated metrics or outcomes associated with that impact.
 - The reach of the program.
 - The quality of the program, including likelihood of program's or organization's ability to accomplish stated goals, including metrics and outcomes, in the timeframe stated.
 - The sustainability of the program.
 - Opportunity for Boehringer Ingelheim employee/volunteer involvement with the program.

- Recommendations from community leaders or recognized experts familiar with the program or organization about its efficiency and effectiveness.
- All benefits and risks including Corporate Reputation pertaining to funding any given program or organization.
- Demonstrated fiscal responsibility and viability of the program and/or organization.
- History or previous support of an organization or program.
- Other criteria as identified by the Foundation Steering Committee pertinent to the assessment of the quality, metrics and/or feasibility of the program.

4. Process for Charitable Donation Review

- Corporate communications reviews all completed charitable donation requests and declines those that are outside the scope of our financial contributions program.
- Larger requests (above a threshold amount defined by Corporate
 Communications) that align with Foundation criteria and scope are
 forwarded to Steering Committee members and other Foundation team
 members for consideration. A consensus among Steering Committee
 members determines whether individual requests are approved or declined
 and assigns a specific financial contribution amount.
- Smaller requests (below a threshold amount defined by Corporate Communications) are reviewed by Corporate Communications members and a recommendation on whether to approve or decline and for a specific financial contribution amount is provided to the Steering Committee for consideration and consensus.
- 5. BI Cares will not award any financial or non-financial contribution in which any benefits will be attributed to BI Cares or to Boehringer Ingelheim Corporation, Boehringer Ingelheim USA Corporation, or any Boehringer subsidiary or affiliated entity or any of their officers, directors or shareholders.
- 6. Funding from BI Cares will not be awarded to the following:
 - Political groups, candidates for political office, or any organization attempting to influence legislation (lobbying).

- Sectarian and religious organizations that do not serve the general public on a non-denominational basis.
- Organizations with a limited constituency (fraternal, trade unions, etc.).
- Organizations soliciting contributions in the form of sponsorships to
 events including dinners, entertainment, golf outings, where something of
 tangible value is received in return. Organizations that are otherwise not
 in keeping with the core company values.
- 7. BI Cares cannot approve every financial contribution request made for eligible and worthy programs. Decisions about contributions from BI Cares will be made at the sole discretion of the Foundation Steering Committee against criteria outlined above after evaluating and comparing requests and considering the contributions budget.
