"public open space, wildlife preserve and nature area, and recreational purposes, and not otherwise"

According to Jacky Totten and Janice Emde, the two living Donors, May Ellis intended the term "recreational purposes" to mean recreational purposes that relate to use of the park in its natural state such as walking trails, beautification of the property, bird watching, and so forth.

- E. Legal Description of Park Property. The legal description of the park property is attached hereto as Exhibit A-4 of New Schedule A.
- 7. Paragraph A of ARTICLE III is deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following is substituted:
 - A. *Trustee Responsibilities*. It shall be the responsibility of the Trustee:
 - 1. To ensure that the Park Property is only used pursuant to Paragraph D of Article II.
 - 2. To first fund park maintenance and secondarily to fund exempt organizations in the Rogue River and Wimer communities. Annual distributions shall be limited pursuant to paragraph B of Article IV.
- 8. The last sentence of the second paragraph of paragraph B of ARTICLE IV is modified to read as follows:
 - The Trust's distribution policy shall be based on the rolling average monthly value of the Trust's assets for the prior Thirty Six (36) months ending December 31.
- 9. Subparagraphs 2 and 3 of paragraph A of ARTICLE V are deleted in their entireties and in lieu thereof the following is substituted:
 - 2. <u>Limitations After the Grantor's Death or Incompetency:</u> After the Grantor's death or incompetency, the successor Trustee shall invest and reinvest the Trust assets (principal and accumulated income) only in CASH, CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT and other short term investments backed by the Guaranty of the United States Government and having a term to maturity of less than Three (3) Years.

- 3. Additional Investment Limitations After the Grantor's Death or Incompetency: In addition to the foregoing limitations ALL non-charitable use assets of this Trust in excess of One and One-Quarter (1.25) times the current year Budget approved by the Trustee of The Hagan Trust shall be managed by The Hagan Trust. The dollar amount of assets to be managed and annual distributions of such assets shall be determined by the Trustee of The Hagan Trust pursuant to subparagraph 2 of paragraph C of Article III of The Hagan Trust. The management of such assets shall be by written agreement between the two Trusts pursuant to paragraph C of Article III of The Hagan Trust. ALL assets received by this Trust from other than The Hagan Trust shall be transferred to The Hagan Trust for management.
- 10. The first paragraph of ARTICLE VI is modified to read as follows:

The Grantor, Dan Hagan, shall serve as Trustee of this Trust until his death or incompetency. Upon the death or incompetency of the Grantor, the successor Trustee shall always be selected by the Trustee of The Hagan Trust pursuant to the Grantor's "Plan for Selecting Successor Trustees of The Hagan Trust." Any successor Trustee of The May Ellis Park Trust shall be subject to removal at any time, with or without cause, by the Trustee of The Hagan Trust.

- 11. Paragraph A of ARTICLE VII is modified to read as follows:
 - A. That charitable distributions shall be limited pursuant to Paragraph B of Article IV and made pursuant to subparagraph 2 of Paragraph A of Article III.
- 12. Paragraph C of ARTICLE VII is modified to read as follows:
 - C. That the Grantor's Intent shall be determined by a thorough and objective reading of the provisions contained in the restated Trust Agreement and attached New Schedule A.

All provisions of Article VII and subsequent interpretation shall be construed and viewed as a complete unit rather than putting a "trick interpretation or twist" on any one word or phrase.

- 13. ARTICLE VIII is modified by adding two new paragraphs, to be designated paragraphs "G" and "H", said new paragraphs to read as follows:
 - G. Filing of Trust Documents. After the Grantor's death or incompetency, the signed original Trust Agreement last filed by the Grantor with the Department of the Treasury and attached New Schedule A last filed by the Grantor with the Department of the Treasury shall be filed with the Circuit Court of Boone County, Missouri, Probate Division with the filing of the Grantor's Last Will and Testament.

- H. Restated Trust Agreement to be Filed in Jackson County, Oregon. The Trust Agreement and its attached Schedule A has been filed with the Recorder of Deeds, Jackson County, Oregon. After filing with the Department of the Treasury, this Restatement and New Schedule A shall be filed with the Recorder of Deeds, Jackson County, Oregon.
- 14. Paragraph F of ARTICLE IX is deleted in its entirety.

The signed cover letter to the Department of the Treasury must display the USPS unique mail identifier and identify that submitted Form 990-PF for the calendar year ending prior to the filing of the 990-PF for the Trust;
- 18. Paragraph H is re-designated as paragraph "G" and is further modified to read as follows:
 - G. Termination of Trust. Following the death or incompetency of the Grantor, the Trustee shall not have the right to terminate this Trust for so long as The Hagan Trust is in existence or as long as this Trust estate is in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) whichever shall last occur. If the event The Hagan Trust is no longer in existence and the Trust estate is less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) and if this Trust can no longer carry out its Purpose, then this Trust may be dissolved, but only after the signature approval of the Trustee, and the signature approval of the all Family Representatives registered with the Trustee. Upon the dissolution of this Trust, the assets of this Trust shall be distributed by the Trustee to one or more exempt charities or exempt organizations located in the Rogue River and Wimer communities which qualify as exempt organizations within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal income tax code.


