- 1. A maximum of three (3) grants will be made to a student earning a baccalaureate degree in four years. However, a student whose course of study <u>requires</u> five (5) years to earn a baccalaureate degree may be awarded a fourth grant.
- 2. Students who have completed their freshman year in college are eligible to have their application considered **provided** they have a 2.75 accumulative grade point average.
- 3. Students who have been granted a scholarship must maintain a 3.0 accumulative grade point average to warrant continuation of the scholarship grant.
- 4. A first time applicant with above sophomore standing must have a 3.0 accumulative grade point average.
- 5. An applicant must be a full time student enrolled in a minimum of 12 quarter or 12 semester hours per term. Special consideration may be given to part-time students.
