Since 2001 the Prescription Assistance Network of Stark County works with the funders, social service agencies and health care providers to help the uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid / Medicare population in Stark County obtain needed medications. The program has achieved more than \$3 million in savings by identifying free or discounted drugs for people in need.
