In 2011, United Way invested \$1,251,155 in support of 25 certified member agencies, other exempt organizations, and United Way initiatives. Below are a few highlights of our efforts:

#### We Partner in Initiatives that Achieve Results

- United Way partners with the Community Foundation of Bloomington and Monroe County to support and manage the Monroe Smart Start Birth-to-Five Coalition. This new initiative is bringing families and communities together to make sure children enter kindergarten healthy, happy, and ready to succeed. More than 50 local leaders from education, government, faith, health, and human services, along with parents and other community members, are active Coalition members. Monroe Smart Start developed a shared definition of school readiness for Monroe County so we can ensure children enter kindergarten ready to learn.
- Working with local early childhood education and health care provides, we bring United Way's Born Learning into childcare centers and pediatricians' offices. Born Learning encourages parents, grandparents, and caregivers to turn everyday tasks into learning experiences.

- In partnership with the City of Bloomington, we launched the community's first Born Learning Play Path in summer 2011.
- With IU Health Bloomington, we ran a successful Kindergarten Countdown camp, increasing kids' readiness to start school by over 10% in seven weeks.
- Together with the Chamber of Commerce, Prosecutor's Office, schools, and other community partners, we formed the High School Plus coalition, which holds summits, publishes an enewsletter, maintains a service guide for at-risk youth, and seeks to bring a youth voice to these issues. Because of United Way's sponsorship of Check & Connect®, a model proven to improve school outcomes and reduce dropouts, the local graduation rate has increased.
- Working with nonprofits, local financial institutions, and government, we launched the Financial Stability Alliance for South Central Indiana that focuses specifically on helping area residents become and stay financially stable.
- We launched Bank on Bloomington in April 2011 to help people receive financial education, open bank accounts, and avoid payday loans and check-cashing fees. Bank On Bloomington is a cooperative iniative of UW, the City of Bloomington, 7 local financial institutions, and other partners.
- The Free Community Tax Service VITA program served 50% more filers, saving over \$350,000 in tax preparation fees. Clients report using those saved funds to pay for food, rent, and utility bills. In partnership with the IRS and others, the FCTS helped low-income people in a four-county area.
- United Way plays a key role in the Community Organizations Active in Disaster for Monroe County, which helps our community be well prepared for any future natural disasters.
- We chair the Emergency Food and Shelter Board, a group of government, faith, and nonprofit leaders, to allocate federal funds that help low-income residents with food, rent, and utility costs.
- United Way provides funding and technical assistance for the Monroe and Owen County "211 Infolink" service. In 2011, 2-1-1 operators responded to 27% more calls, fielding 5,277 inquiries and making 6,254 referrals to community resources. Most callers were seeking help with housing and utilities assistance, family support, medical care, income support, and food.
- Monroe and Owen County households saved \$68,839 (and average of 36%) in prescription drug costs through the FamilyWize discount prescription drug card.
- We are helping IU Health Bloomington Hospital review future sites considerations.
- United Way is collaborating with the YMCA of Monroe County, the City Parks and Recreation Department, the County Health Department, and others to promote ACHIEVE, a community-wide wellness initiative.
- We have full accreditation from United Way Worldwide, meeting or exceeding all membership standards. In the past few years, we earned the Chamber workforce award, a statewide communications award, the Chamber family-friendly workplace award, and a Midwest staff excellence award.
- We bring critical funding into our community by providing important information to local, state and federal officials.
- United Way completed the Service Community Assessment of Needs [SCAN], and will release the final report in mid 2012.
- With the City of Bloomington, Community Foundation, and SPEA, we sponsored the NonProfit Alliance of Monroe County, which brings trainings, networking and outreach opportunities to help strengthen the operations of all nonprofit organizations and prepare future professionals.
- Working with Indiana University and others, we support Serve IT, an IU initiative that assists local nonprofit organizations with a wide range of technological services.
- We worked with management, union, and state, and local officials to assist workers who have become displaced from their jobs.
- United Way's Day of Action placed over 120 volunteers at 9 area agencies.
- In collaboration with the Monroe County Public Library, we host and provide materials for the nonprofit resource center and co-sponsored free access to a national grant search service for local agencies.
