## Indiana Academy of Science: Facts and Circumstances

The Indiana Academy of Science (IAS) was founded in 1885 as a nonprofit corporation devoted to scientific and educational purposes. Specifically it promotes scientific research and the diffusion of scientific information; encourages communications and cooperation among scientists, especially in Indiana; prepares scientific reports; and seeks to improve education in the sciences. It also endeavors to serve, upon request of appropriate state officials, to act as an advisory body.

- 1. FINANCIAL SUPPORT FACTOR: We believe that the IAS does readily meet the tenpercent-of-support-requirement. This support comes in the form of an annual allocation from the State of Indiana to support publication of the *Proceedings of the IAS* and from annual membership dues and contributions from members. The financial support of the membership goes, in part, toward publication of scientific work of interest and beneficial to the public in the state of Indiana (and beyond); public meetings where research undertaken by governmental, university/college, and other scientists is presented; and youth programs in the form of high school student research grants, science fairs, and competitions.
- 2. SOURCES OF SUPPORT: The current IAS membership numbers approximately 750 from across the state of Indiana. We actively solicit college student members (distinct from youth programs covered in item 1 above) and seek to provide them a forum for their career development. Our public meetings are typically held on college/university campuses in various part of Indiana in ensure access to the broadest possible audience.
- 3. REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNING BODY: Our governing body is broadly representative of scientists and science educators in Indiana. As provided in our constitution and bylaws, it is elected from the general membership. The President typically serves a single one-year term after serving as President-elect. The elected Section Chairs are central to the governing body and are from a broad range of educational and public-private agencies. They too serve a one-year term after serving as Co-chair.
- 4. AVAILABILITY OF PUBLIC SERVICES: The programs and activities of the IAS are broad, available and open to the public, and include significant outreach that provides public access to scientific resources of Indiana.
  - a. Youth program These programs include Science Olympiad, Science Talent Search, and Junior Academy. They are open to high school students from

throughout the state. In addition, we select a Speaker of the Year, who makes a presentation open to the public and whose further travel to schools is subsidized by IAS funds. Until 2009, the IAS offered an annual award for a high school teaching fellow for projects designed to improve scientific understanding and invigorate the teaching of science at the secondary school level.

- b. College science students We make available low cost student memberships, mentor college student research through grants and venues for public presentation, and provide potential publication (without charge) of completed research in the peer reviewed *Proceedings of the IAS*.
- c. Availability of research grants annually the IAS awards approximately 30 small (i.e., maximum \$3000) grants on the basis of scientific merit. Many of these go to young scientists dong graduate studies at colleges and universities in Indiana; others are awarded to scientists throughout the state and representing as many as 17 distinct disciplinary areas.
- d. Activities of our membership broadly support science in the public interest. This takes the traditional form of conducting, presenting, and publishing scientific research, especially work that is of benefit to the citizens of Indiana. We hold topical workshops and performances that benefit science educators within our membership and beyond. During the past three years we have run or supported a series of bioblitzes, public programming that increases our citizenries understanding and appreciation for biodiversity. Most recently we were financial supporters of a 4 part public television series produced by WFYI (Indianapolis PBS station) on the Natural History of our state.
- e. The IAS maintains a historic collection of over 12,000 volumes housed in the State Library that provides for the public use of the material.
- f. Over the past three years we have converted *Proceedings of the IAS* to pdf format for free access on our public website (www.indianaacademyofscience.org). In addition, we exchange print copies of Academy publications with other scientific research institutions (and these become part of our library collection house in the State Library). Material is acquired from almost every state and approximately 75 foreign countries. Many of the titles in the collection are quite valuable, relatively scarce, and not widely held in other U.S. libraries, especially not in Indiana.

g. We subsidize the production of Special Publications, book length, color illustrated volumes that draw upon the expertise within the IAS. These hardbound books cover topics of importance to the citizenry of Indiana and adjacent states, especially those related to biodiversity.

5. ADDITIONAL FACTORS: Membership is encouraged for anyone with interests in scientific endeavors and includes secondary school educators, college/university professors, governmental agency scientists, scientists in the private sector, retirees, and hobbyists; membership dues are modest and below those of similar state academies of science.
