

In May of 2010, the Bloomington Bicycle Club and J&B Events Management, Inc. came to an agreement on the disposition and organization on the Touring Ride through Rural Indiana (TRIRI), a series of week-long bicycle camping and lodging tours. The Bloomington Bicycle Club agreed to continue organizing the one-day Ride Across Indiana as a fundraising ride, while TRIRI was ceded to J&B Events Management, Inc. The formal separation into two entities was completed in early January, 2011, with J&B Events Management receiving the TRIRI cash reserves used to capitalize the next season's rides. Joe Anderson, principal of J&B Events Management, resigned as treasurer of the Bloomington Bicycle Club in January, 2011, to continue organizing TRIRI.
