Berkley Corporation Charitable Foundation the Foundation made distributions from assets from sources other than current income. Collectively, the distributions in excess of current income totaled 365,473. This amount represents over 25 of the Foundations net assets of 282,181 as measured by fair market value at the beginning of the Foundations taxable year ending December 31, 2011. Although the Foundation technically experienced a substantial contraction, it will continue in existence and has no plans for dissolution.
