



**The Dollars for Doers Program is offered to recognize the volunteer efforts of Brunswick Corporation Employees for nonprofit organizations.**

## **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?**

Active, Full-Time Employees of Brunswick Corporation.

## **WHICH ORGANIZATIONS ARE ELIGIBLE?**

Eligible organizations must be federally tax exempt, nonprofit that have been granted exemption under section 501(c)(3) (**Attach copy of verification from the IRS.**) and ruled to be publicly supported under section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. Contributions are not made to religious organizations for religious purposes; for any form of political activity; to non-qualified military veteran organizations, fraternal orders or labor groups; for loans of any kind; or, for trips, tours, dinners, tickets or advertising. The Foundation does not have and is not able to donate equipment or products.

## **WHAT TYPES OF VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES ARE ELIGIBLE?**

Examples of eligible volunteer activities include long-term efforts such as serving on a nonprofit Board of Directors or committee, scout leaders, etc. Participation in single short-term events such as a bowl-a-thon or food drive also qualifies. *Group Volunteer Service must;*

- be performed without pay or compensation of any kind;
- demonstrate that a meaningful, positive contribution has been made to the nonprofit organization.

## **HOW MUCH IS AWARDED?**

Individual volunteer grants range from \$75 to \$125. Group volunteer grants range up to \$1,000, depending on the number of employees involved, the amount of money raised and the time spent. **A check will not be issued prior to the event.** Individual and group grants will be reviewed and approved by the Brunswick Foundation. Organizations are eligible for one award per employee per calendar year for long-term efforts.

## **HOW DO I APPLY?**

Employees obtain forms from their local Human Resources Office or on BC One under the Foundation Site. Single employee must complete "For Individual Volunteer Service" section and a group of employees must complete "For Group Volunteer Service" section on Part A of the request form, **plus attach a copy of the 501(c)(3) verification (from the IRS).** The form is then returned to their local Human Resources Office for employee verification (Part B) and then forwarded to the Brunswick Foundation, 1 N. Field Ct., Lake Forest, IL 60045.

## **WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?**

Checks will be issued in September and February. **Checks will be mailed directly to the organization. It is important that the address given is the correct mailing address.** Employee and local HR Department will receive a letter confirming of the donation.

*The administration and financing of this program is exclusively the responsibility of The Brunswick Foundation, which has full authority to make rules and regulations governing the program and to make final decisions in all matters arising in connection therewith.
