THE DOW GARDENS, A DIVISION OF THE HERBERT H. & GRACE A. DOW FOUNDATION, IS A BOTANICAL GARDEN THAT DISPLAYS NATIVE AND INTERNATIONALLY SELECTED TREES, SHRUBS, AND HERBACEOUS PLANTS IN LANDSCAPE SETTINGS. FURTHER, 15,000 BEDDING PLANTS 23,000 SPRING BULBS, AND HUNDREDS OF PERENNIALS ARE PLANTED AND TESTED THROUGHOUT THE GARDENS. THE OVERALL GOAL IS TO EVALUATE AND DOCUMENT WHAT WILL GROW IN CENTRAL MICHIGAN, AS WELL AS, TO EDUCATE AND ENTERTAIN THE PUBLIC WITH CLASSES AND TOURS.

IN 2011, THE GARDENS HOSTED 111,865 VISITORS. ITS PROFESSIONAL STAFF REFINED THE WEBSITE, WORKED WITH MASS MEDIA, INTERACTED WITH CVB AND CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, AND DEVELOPED A SERIES OF PROGRAMS TO ATTRACT U.S. VISITORS. HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDED TWO "ART IN THE GARDENS" EXHIBITIONS FEATURING ARTISTS OF THE GREAT LAKES BAY REGION, AS WELL AS A SERIES OF MUSICAL PROGRAMS IN THE GARDENS AND SEMINARS FEATURING NATIONALLY ACCLAIMED HORTICULTURISTS.
