(d.) Guidelines for Grant Seekers

The Consumers Energy Foundation was established to provide financial support to primarily Michigan organizations that are classified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Eligibility

The Foundation awards grants to innovative projects and activities creating measurable impact in five major fields of interest:

- **Social Welfare** initiatives that provide preventative solutions to problems faced by individuals and families who are unable to address their own needs, with special interest for the elderly and low-income households;
- **Michigan Growth and Environmental Enhancement** efforts that protect and enhance Michigan's physical environment, with emphasis on programs dedicated to environmental education, energy conservation, brownfield redevelopment, air and water quality and involving multiple partners;
- **Education** initiatives directed primarily to schools of higher learning with special interest in scholarship and internship programs and curricula and capital improvements in the study of business, political science, economics,

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engineering and natural/physical sciences as they relate to the energy industry;

- **Community and Civic Development** endeavors that support programs focusing on Michigan's economic development at the community, regional and statewide levels, with a preference given to volunteer-driven efforts, public/private partnerships and short- or long-term projects with significant evaluation components;
- **Culture and the Arts** programs that create a wider recognition of Michigan's cultural assets, build new audiences, provide services to regions or populations who would otherwise be unable to participate and demonstrate significant involvement on the part of business or community leaders.

The Foundation will consider requests from qualified organizations to support operating budgets and capital fund programs for the construction, refurbishment or purchase of buildings, structures, equipment or physical enhancements. Normally, the foundation will not contribute to endowments.

Geographic Focus

The principal focus of the Consumers Energy Foundation includes those communities in Michigan's Lower Peninsula where Consumers Energy has a business presence. Requests will be considered from organizations located elsewhere for programs or projects that significantly benefit the State of Michigan and the communities served by Consumers Energy.

Limitations

The Foundation does not support the following:

- individuals
- individual scholarships
- individual sponsorships related to fund-raising
- organizations that do not qualify as charitable organizations as defined by the Internal Revenue Service
- organizations that practice discrimination on the basis of sex, age, height, weight, marital status, race, religion, sexual orientation, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, disability, handicap, or veteran status
- political organizations and political campaigns

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- religious organizations when the contribution will be used for denominational or sectarian purposes
- labor or veterans organizations
- fraternal orders
- social clubs
- debt reduction campaigns
- sports tournaments
- talent or beauty contests
- loans for small business

The Foundation does not purchase tickets or make payments to events or celebrations to raise funds for charitable purposes, nor does it sponsor advertising supporting these efforts.

Volunteer Investment Program

The Consumers Energy Foundation recognizes and supports employees and retirees who volunteer their time and talent to improve the quality of life in their communities. Through the Volunteer Investment Program, the Foundation awards grants to nonprofit organizations on behalf of employee and retiree volunteers.

Matching Gifts Program

The Foundation also administers a matching gift program for employees and retirees of CMS Energy Corporation and its subsidiaries and the CMS Energy board of directors. This program supports qualifying Michigan colleges and universities, community foundations, food banks and homeless shelters. Contributions are matched dollar for dollar up to \$1,000 per employee/board member and 50 percent per retiree up to \$1,000 in any calendar year.
