  - sources, amounts, and nature of resources contributed by the applicant and other supporters of the project.
- 3. A list of any other grant-making agencies to which the application for support has been made.
- 4. A copy of the ruling granting federal tax exemption under 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 5. A list of the members of the governing board.
