An audit includes consideration of internal control over financial reporting as a basis for designing audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements, assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audits provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

As described in Note 2 to the financial statements, these financial statements were prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position arising from cash transactions of CUNA Mutual Group Foundation, Inc. at December 31, 2011 and 2010, and its activities and changes in its net assets arising from cash transactions for the years then ended, on the basis of accounting described in Note 2 to the financial statements.

#### (1) Organization and Income Tax Status

The CUNA Mutual and CUMIS Charitable Foundation, Inc. was organized in 1967 under the laws of Wisconsin as a non-stock, nonprofit organization. The name was later changed to the CUNA Mutual Group Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation").

The Foundation makes donations to charitable and community activities as approved by its Board of Directors. It is primarily funded by contributions from CUNA Mutual Insurance Society, now known as CMFG Life Insurance Company ("CUNA Mutual, or CMIS"), an Iowa mutual insurer organized for the purpose of serving the insurance needs of credit unions and their members.

The Foundation is exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation is, however, subject to an excise tax of 1% of investment income.

The results of the Foundation are affected by its transactions and relationships with CUNA Mutual. See Note 3 for a discussion of related-party transactions. The results of the Foundation's operations may have materially differed from the results recorded if the Company did not have these relationships.

#### (2) Basis of Presentation and Accounting Policies

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements (cash-basis). Accordingly, revenues and expenses are recognized when received and paid, respectively; and accrued income and expenses have not been recorded. This basis of accounting varies from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, the aggregate effect of which has not been determined.

All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor. However, if a restriction is fulfilled in the same time period in which the contribution is received, the organization reports the support as unrestricted. No restricted contributions have been received by the Foundation.

#### (3) Contributions and Administrative Expenses

The CUNA Mutual Board of Directors approves annual contributions to the Foundation to be paid by CUNA Mutual.

Contributions are recorded when received and donations are recorded when paid. Contributions made by CUNA Mutual consisted of cash contributions in the amount of \$650,000, in both 2011 and 2010.

CUNA Mutual provides office space, equipment and staff to the Foundation, which does not have any employees or fixed assets. The estimated value of such contributed services and assets was \$94,000 and \$89,000 for 2011 and 2010, respectively. These amounts are not reflected in the accompanying statements of activities or changes in net assets arising from cash transactions.

#### (4) Commitments

The Foundation has made future financial commitments to make donations to various organizations. These commitments, totaling \$285,000 and \$160,000 as of December 31, 2011 and 2010, respectively, are not recognized in the financial statements. In certain circumstances, recipient organizations may change the plans which led to the Foundation's commitment to make future donations. If this occurs, the Foundation may reduce or eliminate its commitment.

#### (5) Subsequent Events

The Foundation evaluated subsequent events through September 14, 2012, the issuance date of these financial statements. During this period, \$454,500 of additional commitments have been made, consisting of \$433,500 for 2012 and \$7,000 annually for 2013, 2014 and 2015.

In June 2011, the Board of Directors of CMIS approved a plan that would convert CMIS from a mutual insurance company structure to a mutual insurance holding company (MHC) structure. In September 2011, policyholders and the Iowa Insurance Commissioner approved the plan to reorganize CMIS into a MHC. The new MHC structure became effective January 31, 2012 and CMIS was renamed CMFG Life Insurance Company.
