The Minnesota Jaycees is a statewide organization consisting of 73 local chapters. Our chapters are in rural, suburban, and urban areas of the state, and our membership is limited to young people between the ages of 18-40 from diverse socio-economic backgrounds.

The Minnesota Jaycees impact the next generation of civic leaders by working to ensure they have the skills, personal resources, and leadership ability to make a positive impact in Minnesota communities. Over the years, hundreds of thousands of young Minnesotans have developed their leadership skills through hands-on service in their communities, finding in themselves the ability to lead.

The Minnesota Jaycees develops leaders by.

- Managing community projects that make a positive impact
- Mentoring and coaching younger members
- Providing trainings and leadership opportunities for members to develop their skills by taking on leadership roles in the local chapter and their community as a whole

In 2011, members of the Minnesota Jaycees contributed around 16,500 volunteer hours on over 900 community projects across the state of Minnesota. With 73 chapters and a total of 2,168 volunteers statewide, the time they contributed in the community as volunteers adds up to a value of over \$3,200,00.00 (using Minnesota's wage averages for similar paid positions).
