THIS ROOM IS DESIGNED FOR YOUTH AND FAMILY RECREATION AND INTERACTION A VARIETY OF GAMES AND ACTIVITIES ARE PROVIDED IN A SUPERVISED ENVIRONMENT FOR YOUTH OF ALL AGES AS WELL AS FAMILIES YOUTH-IN-GOVERNMENT - ABOUT 45 YOUTHS ANNUALLY EXPERIENCE STATE GOVERNMENT IN ACTION AS THEY SIMULATE A DEMOCRATIC POLITICAL SYSTEM ALL ASPECTS OF OUR POLITICAL SYSTEM ARE EXPLORED AS PARTICIPANTS SERVE AS VARIOUS PLAYERS IN THE POLITICAL ARENA DURING A PSEUDO-LEGISLATIVE SESSION FAMILY/YOUTH EVENTS - PROVIDING FAMILIES AND YOUTH WITH PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS IN A SAFE AND POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT THAT WILL ENHANCE PERSONAL AND SOCIAL SKILLS, TEACH LEADERSHIP AND RESPONSIBILITY, AND PROMOTE INDIVIDUAL SELF-ESTEEM WITH THE YMCA'S CORE VALUES OF CARING, HONESTY, RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY AND FAITH, THE PARTICIPANTS WILL GAIN NEW FRIENDSHIPS, BUILD SELF-CONFIDENCE AND DISCOVER PERSONAL TALENTS THIS PROGRAM SERVES APPROXIMATELY 327 PARTICIPANTS, THROUGH TEEN SOCIALS AND SPECIAL FAMILY EVENTS YOUTH LEADERSHIP - YOUTH, GRADES 7 - 12, ARE INVOLVED IN EXPERIMENTAL LEARNING EXPERIENCES WHICH ENCOURAGE RESPONSIBLE CITIZENSHIP, PROMOTE AN UNDERSTANDING OF GOVERNMENTAL PROCESSES, AND PROVIDE LEADERSHIP SKILLS PROGRAMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, MODEL UNITED NATIONS AND YOUTH VOICE IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ANCILLARY- THIS AREA INCLUDES ALL SERVICES NOT PROPERLY INCLUDED ELSEWHERE AS A SERVICE TO OUR VALUED MEMBERS AND VISITORS, THE CHILD WATCH PROGRAM PROVIDES ON-SITE CHILD CARE FOR FAMILIES AND OUR GUESTS WHILE ENJOYING OUR FACILITY OUR GOAL IS TO PROVIDE A POSITIVE EXPERIENCE FOR CHILDREN IN A SAFE AND SECURE ENVIRONMENT IT OFFERS INTERESTING AND INVITING AGE-APPROPRIATE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED BY WARM AND FUN STAFF MEMBERS SNACK AND BEVERAGE MACHINES ARE PROVIDED AS A CONVENIENCE TO MEMBERS FACILITY RENTALS INCLUDING BIRTHDAY PARTIES AND OVERNIGHT RENTALS ARE ALSO INCLUDED IN THIS DEPARTMENT MANAGEMENT OF CITY POOL - IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CITY OF MANKATO THE MANKATO FAMILY YMCA OVERSEES THE DAILY OPERATIONS OF THE CITY OWNED TOURTELLOTTE POOL THE YMCA HIRES AND TRAINS ALL STAFF, INCLUDING FRONT DESK, CONCESSIONS, LIFEGUARDS AND MANAGERS THE YMCA RUNS SWIMMING LESSONS, SCHEDULES AND STAFFS RENTALS, WORKS WITH THE MANTAS UNITED STATES SWIMMING PROGRAM AND THE USA DIVING PROGRAM WHILE THEY PRACTICE AND HOLD MEETS AT THE FACILITY SCHOOL BASED MENTOR PROGRAM - THIS PROGRAM IS A COLLABORATION WITH DISTRICT 77 SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH A MENTOR THEY MEET WITH THE STUDENT AT THE SCHOOL ONCE A WEEK FOR AN HOUR OVER THE ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR THE MENTOR IS ANOTHER POSITIVE ADULT ROLE MODEL IN THIS STUDENT'S LIFE THAT CAN ENCOURAGE THEM WITH PEERS, SOCIAL SKILLS, HOME LIFE AND ACADEMICS THE PROGRAM SERVED 102 STUDENTS AT 4 DIFFERENT ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS WITH BUSINESS PARTNERSHIPS FROM 6 BUSINESSES VOLUNTEER PROGRAM THERE ARE MANY AREAS THAT VOLUNTEERS SERVE AT THE YMCA, FROM YOUTH SPORT COACHES, PRESCHOOL, AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS, MENTORING AND MANY MORE AREAS THE VOLUNTEER PROGRAM PREPARES A VOLUNTEER FOR THE AREA THAT THEY WILL SERVE IN AND PROVIDES THEM A CONTACT PERSON TO GET STARTED MANY OF THE YMCA VOLUNTEERS ARE FROM THE LOCAL COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES
