RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION AND DECLARATION OF TRUST CREATING THE MAQUOKETA AREA FOUNDATION, ALSO KNOWN AS THE MAQUOKETA AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION TO "COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF JACKSON COUNTY."

WHEREAS, a Resolution and declaration of trust creating the Maquoketa Area Foundation was signed and dated July 13, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Article X of the trust agreement provides that the terms of the trust agreement may be modified by resolution adopted by the affirmative votes of five members of the Distribution Committee when approved by a majority of the members of the Trustee's Committee; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution amending the declaration of trust was adopted October 18, 2003, changing the name of the organization to the Maquoketa Area Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Distribution Committee has determined that it would be beneficial to the organization to change the name of the organization to "Community Foundation of Jackson County."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Distribution Committee as follows:

The Resolution and declaration of trust for the Maquoketa Area Community Foundation dated July 13, 1982 is hereby amended to change the name of the organization to COMMUNITY FOUDNATION OF JACKSON COUNTY.
