(Code) (Expenses \$ 190,962 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$ Missouri Mission of Mercy (MOMOM) Another large project the MDAF undertook this year was sponsoring the first Missouri Mission of Mercy (MOMOM) event, September 23-24, 2011 in Springfield And what an incredible event it was! The two-day MOMOM dental clinic was a resounding success serving 1,856 patients and providing \$1,108,994 in free dental care. The event was the vision of co-chairs Drs. Darren and Sarah Mahaffey who, along with a local committee in Springfield, spent more than a year planning the clinic. This involved fundraising, procuring discounted and in-kind donations and planning, planning, planning! The total amount in monetary donations received was \$115,670. The discounted and in-kind figure is a little harder to pin down because some groups didnt provide values, but the number of companies and organizations that helped us out in big and small ways was astounding (a complete sponsor list is available on the MOMOM webpage, referenced below) And of course, none of this could have happened without all the incredible volunteers The 1,046 volunteers included 178 dentists, 83 hygienists, 170 Assistants, 3 Physicians, 25 nurses, and 587 general volunteers. Services provided included 1,447 filling and 2,922 extractions, along with other procedures such as cleanings, root canals, and limited lab work. Patients also were given medication as appropriate and provided meals while they waited for treatment. You can see more about MOMOM online at www modental org/momom. One of the MDAFs largest projects in 2011 has been its work related to the Joplin disaster. The May 22 tornado impacted nearly 40% of the dental workforce in Joplin and four members lost their homes as well Many of the stories from our members and an overview of the MDAs response to this tragedy have been well documented in the Focus A key part of that response was the creation of a Disaster Relief Fund by the MDAF Board The fund provided a central charitable collection source for the wave of generosity that poured in from across the country. To date more \$175,000 has been collected. This has allowed the Board a way to assist dentists in the aftermath of this tragedy, and to have in place a response mechanism for future disasters. The Board and staff spent many hours with legal counsel to ensure the protection of our non-profit status and to develop the required guidelines for distributing financial assistance. At the time of this report, close to \$25,000 had been used in immediate support of Joplin dentists and applications for larger requests are being accepted and reviewed. In addition, the ADA provided \$50,000 in direct relief to Joplin dentists, and the MDA Board of Trustees also has made plans to provide assistance as necessary The MDA Foundation is no longer accepting donations specifically for the Joplin disaster, but rather has established a general Disaster Relief Fund to continue to help Joplin, but also to help other dentists with future disasters should they happen

The MDA Foundation continues to offer its long-standing Dental and Dental Hygiene Scholarship Program in 2011 For the 2011-2012 academic year, the MDAF awarded eight \$2,000 dental scholarships (two of which were sponsored by MDIS) and four \$500 dental hygiene scholarships Last year, the MDAF received only three dental scholarship applications although 10 scholarships were available. The MDAF Board and staff worked very hard this year to promote the scholarship program and were pleased to have received 15 dental scholarship applications in 2011 However, there was a decline in the number of dental hygiene scholarship applications this year, dropping from 18 last year to nine this year. The MDAF is eager to assist our future dentists and hygienists and asks that you promote this program in your communities. The DVD is a fun, lighthearted tale of Samantha, a 12-year-old girl obsessed with losing her last (crooked) baby tooth in order to obtain the perfect smile and to win the heart of the new boy at school. This 17-minute entertaining and educational film teaches the importance of dental health to young audiences, helping to develop the important habit at an early age. The makers of Crooked have developed curriculum for teachers to use along with the DVD to teach their students about the importance of oral health in a new and innovative way.
