## ANNUAL REPORT

### HIS HOUSE OF COLUMBIA, INC.

#### I. Christian Human Services

##### A. Objectives

1. To proclaim the “Good News – the Gospel of Christ” to any person
2. To minister the Christian Sacraments and other church activities such as the Lord’s Supper, baptisms, marriages, funerals and praise and worship services.
3. To provide Bibles and study guides to all persons in the Church and chapel services, shelters, mission, thrift shops, and etc.
4. To provide an in-house and self-improvement program for recovering alcoholic men, including their shelter, food, clothes, in-kind services, and etc.
5. To provide night-time shelter, food, clothes and toiletry supplies to homeless and transient men.
6. To provide clothes and shoes to indigent persons.
7. To provide Christian guidance and encouragement to indigent, homeless and recovering alcoholic men.
8. To support programs that witness and minister Christian principles in jails and schools locally.
9. To support missionary activities locally and worldwide.
10. To provide the above objectives and following services from the proceeds of thrift shops sales of donated merchandise and goods from John Q. Public.

B. Services Provided

1. 20,954 persons heard the Good News in chapel, jails, churches, thrift shops and etc.
2. 578 Meeting Street Chapel services, Eternity Bible School sessions, Street Outreach services, morning chapel services, marriages and funerals officiated, and sacraments were administered.
3. 4,679 Bibles, Christian books or crosses were given to indigent adults, jailed persons, local youth, and etc.
4. 2,079 recovering alcoholic men were in His House programs, 29,440 meals were provided to program participants, and 2,183 recovering alcoholic men received medical, dental, or eye care and other human services.
5. 1,352 homeless or transient men were sheltered and provided with hygiene and toiletry supplies and 18,980 meals were provided to homeless, transient, or street persons.
6. 2,756 indigent persons received free clothes or shoes.
7. 11,719 persons received Christian guidance.
8. 9 persons receiving Christian Scholarships totaling \$12,000 and 240 prayer breakfasts and luncheons and Fellowship of Christian Athletes meetings were attended by staff.
9. 17 groups engaged in local or international missionary activities were given regular support.
10. 3,571 pickups of donated items were made by His House trucks and 13,213 donation receipts were issued to John Q. Public.
