This FIRST AMENDMENT (this "Amendment") to the HUFF FAMILY FOUNDATION U/A/D NOVEMBER 16, 2005 (the "Foundation"), is made this 12th day of March, 2012, by and among Steven T. Huff, as Trustor (the "Trustor"), and Steven T. Huff, Thomas M. Huff, and Susan A. Huff, as Trustees (collectively, the "Trustees").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Trustor created the Foundation by signing the Trust Agreement dated November 16, 2005 (the "Trust Agreement") and appointing the Trustees as the Trustees of the Foundation:

WHEREAS, under Article 10 of the Trust Agreement, the Trust Agreement is governed by the law of the Commonwealth of Virginia;

WHEREAS, in order to further certain charitable purposes, the Trustor and the Trustees desire that the name of the Foundation be changed;

WHEREAS, the parties to this Amendment, who constitute all of the "interested persons" with respect to the Trust (as described in section 55-541.11 of the Code of Virginia, as amended), agree that the name of the Trust should be changed; and

WHEREAS, the parties to this Amendment believe that this Amendment does not violate a material purpose of the Trust, but instead believe this Amendment furthers and enhances the material purposes of the Trust.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties to this Amendment agree as follows:

- 1. This Amendment's Recitals are included in and deemed to be restated in this Section 1.
- 2. The parties hereby delete ARTICLE I in its entirety and substitute the following ARTICLE I in lieu thereof:

ARTICLE 1. ESTABLISHMENT

Trustor hereby establishes the PENSMORE FOUNDATION (the "Foundation").

- 3. In all other respects, the parties hereby ratify, reaffirm, republish, and redeclare the Trust Agreement.
- 4. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original and all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.
