	March 25, 2011, Federal Judge Emmett Sullivan vacated an August, 2008 rule issued by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service that removed all Endangered Species Act (ESA) protection for "Ginny," and restored federal legal protection for this small nocturnal
	resident of West Virginia's highest mountains. Under this program we also advocate for the little brown bat, threatened by white
	nose syndrome and other rare species of West Virginia. We advocated for studies on bats in Blackwater Canon caves. The studies
	revealed that bats there were dying from white nose syndrome. We also reported on threats to the golden eagle from industrial wind
	turbines and advocated for stronger regulation to protect all avian species threatened by this new industry.
