CHILD SUPPORT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. AT LEAST ONE PARENT MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE NORTH CAROLINA CHILD SUPPORT COUNCIL, EMPLOYEE OF A CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, OR A CLIENT OF THE CHILD SUPPORT PROGRAM (EITHER THROUGH IV-D SERVICES OR ACC CLERK OF COURT SERVICES).
- 2. APPLICANT MUST BE A RESIDENT OF NORTH CAROLINA AND A GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR.
- 3. APPLICANT MUST HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED TO A SCHOOL OF HIGHER LEARNING IN PURSUIT OF A DEGREE OR CERTIFICATION, SPECIFICALLY A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR TECHNICAL INSTITUTE. APPLICANT MUST COMPLETE AND SIGN HIS OR HER OWN APPLICATION.

- 4. APPLICANT MUST HAVE MAINTAINED AN OVERALL C AVERAGE DURING HIS OR HER HIGH SCHOOL CAREER.
- 5. APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MARCH 15.
- 6. THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE AWARDED AT THE ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON NCCSC. IN THE EVENT THAT THE RECIPIENT FAILS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL FOR ANY REASON OR MAINTAIN A MINIMUM GPA OF 2.5, THE SECOND SEMESTER MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED.
- 7. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION, THE STATE WILL BE DIVIDED INTO THREE REGIONS.
- 8. EACH REGION WILL HAVE A CHILD SUPPORT COUNCIL BOARD MEMBER WHO WILL APPOINT A REGIONAL COMMITTEE TO ADVERTISE THE AVAILABILITY OF THE SCHOLARSHIP. THIS COMMITTEE WILL ALSO RECEIVE THE APPLICATIONS AND MAKE A REGIONAL SELECTION THAT WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE FOR THE FINAL REVIEW AND SELECTION.
