#### Note 1 Nature of Activities

The Light Foundation (the "Foundation") is a not-for-profit corporation, established in 2001, and is governed by a volunteer board of trustees. The Foundation's mission is to promote student participation in unique outdoor learning experiences that assist them in becoming responsible members of their communities. This mission is focused on students in Southwestern Ohio and the Greater Boston area. The Foundation accomplishes its mission either by directly organizing and coordinating training programs and outdoor camps, or by contributing funding to other qualifying organizations that meet the Foundation's criteria. The Foundation's support comes from individual and corporate donors, and from fundraising events.

#### Note 2 Significant Accounting Policies

The summary of significant accounting policies of the Foundation is presented to assist in understanding the organization's financial statements. The financial statements and notes are representations of the Foundation's management, who is responsible for their integrity and objectivity. These accounting policies conform to generally accepted accounting principles and have been consistently applied in the preparation of the financial statements.

#### Basis of accounting

The accounts are maintained and the financial statements are presented on the accrual basis.

#### Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, and the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements, and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### Excess of revenues over expenses

The statement of activities includes excess of revenues over expenses. Changes in unrestricted net assets which are excluded from excess of revenues over expenses, consistent with industry practice, include unrealized gains and losses on investments.

#### Income taxes

The Foundation is a tax exempt organization as described under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), and, as such, is not subject to income taxes on income received for exempt purposes.

The Foundation's Forms 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2008, remain subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service.

#### Investments

Investments in marketable securities with readily determinable fair values are reported at their fair values in the statement of financial position. Unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in unrestricted net assets.

#### Note 2 Significant Accounting Policies (cont.)

#### Advertising costs

Advertising costs are expensed in the year incurred. During 2011 and 2010, \$864 and \$0 were paid for advertising costs.

#### Functional expense reporting

The cost of providing program and supporting services has been summarized by function, based on estimates developed by management.

## Property and equipment

Purchased property and equipment is recorded at cost. Donations of equipment are recorded as contributions at their estimated fair value. Depreciation is accounted for on the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets. Depreciation expense for the years ended December 31, 2011 and 2010 was \$22,878 and \$12,126, respectively.

Expenditures for maintenance and repairs are deducted from income in the period incurred. Expenditures for major items are capitalized. Costs of assets sold or retired and the related amounts of accumulated depreciation are eliminated from the accounts in the year of sale or retirement.

#### Concentration of credit risk

The Foundation, at times, has cash deposits in excess of federally insured limits. It also maintains cash in a money market account with a brokerage firm. These accounts may exceed the maximum limit which is guaranteed by the Securities Investors Protection Corporation. FASB ASC 825 Financial Instruments identifies these items as a concentration of credit risk requiring disclosure, regardless of the degree of risk. The risk is managed by maintaining all deposits in high quality financial institutions.

#### Cash and cash equivalents

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Foundation considers funds in the money market account to be cash equivalents.

#### Contributions

The Foundation does not solicit pledged contributions; therefore, contributions are recognized at time of actual receipt. Depending on the existence or nature of any donor restrictions, contributions received are required to be recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted.

#### Contributed Services

No amounts have been reflected in the financial statements for donated services. The Foundation generally pays for services requiring specific expertise. However, many individuals volunteer their time and perform a variety of tasks that assist the Foundation in various ways, but these services do not meet the criteria for recognition as contributed services.

#### Note 3 Investments Securities

#### Investments

Marketable securities are held as available-for-sale and are shown on the statements of financial position at fair value. Cost, fair value, and investment returns at December 31, 2011 and 2010 are summarized as follows

Proceeds from the sale of investment securities available for sale were \$267,078 in 2011 and \$232,344 in 2010.

The Foundation owns shares in Industrial Income Trust, which is a nontraded real estate investment trust (REIT) organized as a corporation. The fair value of the investment at December 31, 2011 and 2010 was \$71,171 and \$65,875, respectively. The REIT's share redemption program provides a limited opportunity in which to redeem its common stock. Shares purchased and held less than four years are subject to a discount from the purchase price of the common stock when redeemed, although shares purchased through the reinvestment program may not be subject to the discount, upon the discretion of the REIT's board of directors. The shares subject to the discount were purchased in June and December, 2010

#### Note 5 Description of Leasing Arrangements

The Foundation has two leasing arrangements with Lighthawk, LLC, whose owner is a major donor. These leasing arrangements cover an exclusive use of 5 acres, and a non-exclusive use of 79 acres, with both tracts of land located in Darke County, Ohio. The Foundation has constructed land improvements on these tracts. Both leases do not require the payment of any rent, expire in June, 2018, and contain options to continually renew the leases for periods of ten years.

#### Note 6 Fair Value Measurements

Generally accepted accounting principles define fair value, establish a framework for measuring fair value, and establish a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. A fair value measurement assumes that the transaction to sell the asset or transfer the liability occurs in the principal market for the asset or liability or, in the absence of a principal market, the most advantageous market. Valuation techniques that are consistent with the market, income, or cost approach are used to measure fair value.

The fair value hierarchy prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value into three broad levels:

- Level 1 Inputs are quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identical assets or liabilities the Foundation has the ability to access.
- Level 2 Inputs (other than quoted prices included within level 1) that are observable for the asset or liability, either directly or indirectly.
- Level 3 Inputs that are unobservable and rely on management's own assumptions in assessing the fair value measurement

#### Note 7 Restrictions on Net Assets

Temporary restrictions on net assets in the amount of \$10,000 at the end of December 31, 2011 are related to funds granted by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Wildlife Division to build a trap shooting range on the Greenville property. Any of these restricted funds not used for this purpose must be returned to the Division. Therefore, they are not available for operating purposes.

#### Note 8 Subsequent Events

The Foundation's management evaluated subsequent events through August 7, 2012, the date these financial statements were available to be issued, to evaluate whether any such events warrant adjustment to any reported amounts or inclusion of additional disclosures.

Management has determined that no events have occurred that would warrant adjustment to amounts reported in these statements as of December 31, 2011.

In 2012, a pavilion shelter, new restrooms, and other improvements were constructed on the Greenville property. The expenditures for these improvements through the date of this report is in the amount of approximately \$365,000. Proceeds received in February, 2012, from a Super Bowl ticket raffle in the amount of \$206,326 were used to help offset these expenditures.
