At any one time the Foundation is funding approximately 1000 scholarships for this program. Scholars must utilize their award within six years of their matriculation date. Consequently, they may defer their award for up to 2 years. Since 1989, 4,750 scholarships have been awarded. Selection of Coca-Cola Scholars is based on a number of factors, with special emphasis on each individual's character, personal merit and background. Merit is demonstrated in a variety of ways: leadership in school, civic, and extracurricular activities; academic achievement; and motivation to serve and succeed in all endeavors. Selection will be sensitive to the ethnic and economic backgrounds of applicants, reflecting as much as possible the demographic profiles of the various selection districts.

In December 1999, the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation received a one-time \$5 million grant from the Joseph B. Whitehead Foundation enabling the Foundation to launch a new Coca-Cola Two-Year Colleges Scholarship Program. In 2000, the Foundation began awarding 400 scholarships annually to students studying at two-year degree granting institutions. These 400 awards are one-time scholarships of \$1,000. Scholarship recipients must utilize their award within five years of receiving the scholarship. 408 scholarships were awarded in 2000 and 400 in years 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 350 in 2009 and 2010. Selection is based on academic achievement and demonstration of outstanding commutment to community through volunteer service. Applicants must be attending a two-year degree granting institution at time of application. In 2011, the Foundation received an additional \$5 million gift to continue to administer the two-year program. In 2002, the Foundation began administering the Johnston Legacy Scholarship Program for the Coca-Cola Enterprises' Charitable Foundation. The CCE Johnston Legacy Scholarships are for children of Coca-Cola Enterprises' employees who are graduating high school seniors pursuing post secondary education. (However, applicants in the inaugural year of the program could be attending college already). In 2010 and 2011, scholarships were awarded to children of Coca-Cola Refreshment employees once CCE's North American Operations were acquired by The Coca-Cola Company. Eligibility is limited to students who are children of employees in non-management graded positions 00-16 and low level management banded 101 positions. Similar to the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation selection

criteria, selection for the CCE Johnston Legacy Scholars is based on each individual's character, personal merit and background. The scholarships will be paid to the educational institution for credit to the account of the recipient so long as the recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent.
