STUDENT APPLICANTS MUST BE RESIDENTS OF EITHER DICKSON, HICKMAN OR HUMPHREYS COUNTY AREAS FOR ELIGIBILITY TO SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED OVER TWO SEMESTERS, APPLY. PROVIDED THE STUDENT MAINTAINS A 2.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND IS CLASSIFIED AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT. AWARD AMOUNTS MAY VARY DEPENDING ON WHETHER THE STUDENT ATTENDS A FOUR

YEAR OR TWO YEAR COLLEGE OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL.
