During 2011, Southern Bancorp Capital Partners ("Southern") failed to meet the one-third public support test. However, Southern did meet the two Facts and Circumstances test requirements by receiving 16% of its support from governmental or public organizations and operating in a manner to attract new and additional public or governmental support on a continuous basis. Southern currently has a full time grant writer on staff that is charged with finding and applying for both governmental and public grants and donations. Over the past four years, Southern applied for approximately \$9.5 million in grants from numerous organizations (Excluding applications to largest donor). However, with the economic recession continuing throughout these year, only 47% of these grant requests were received. In addition to the two requirements of the facts and circumstances test, Southern has also tried to meet the five public support factors as follows:

### Percentage of Financial Support

Although Southern was not able to meet the public support test in 2010 and 2011, they maintained an average Public Support Test Percentage of 31% from 2005-2011. This is broken down as follows:

2011—16%

2010 - 17%

2009 – 16%

2008 - 20%

2007 - 41%

2006 - 44%

2005 - 63%

With the economic downturn that occurred in 2008, it has become increasingly hard to obtain or renew new and existing grants. Over the last 3 years, Southern has applied for funds from numerous grantors. However, the rejection rate on these applications has been considerably higher than the years preceding 2008 (see attached Appendix A).

All of the individuals listed above are very active in their communities and joined Southern's Board due to the community development mission of the Organization.

### **Availability of Public Facilities or Services Factor**

Southern's mission is to revitalize communities mainly in the Mississippi Delta Region, which is one of the most economically depressed areas in the Country. This mission is carried out by providing grants and loans directly to local organizations for the following purposes:

- Education
- Healthcare
- Job Creation
- Small Business Creation and Growth

In 2010, Southern awarded \$6.1 million to the Arkadelphia Promise Foundation for college scholarships to graduates of Arkadelphia Public Schools. This grant will be paid over an 18 year period.

Over the last 7 years, Southern has granted over \$10 million to local organizations including:

- \$750,000 to build a 24 hour Childcare facility
- \$983,000 to Helena, AR public schools for LEAD Program
- \$295,000 to Boys and Girls Club in Helena, AR
- \$800,000 to the City of Drew, MS for downtown building restoration
- \$350,000 to restore Civil War site in Helena, AR

Southern has also provided loaned money over the same 6 year period to Schools, Civic Organizations, and Small Businesses that normally would not qualify for conventional financing.

- \$10.5 million loaned to Public Charter Schools in Arkansas
- \$2.6 million loaned to Civic Organizations such as Counseling Clinics, Educational Coops and Libraries.

• Approximately \$7.2 million loaned to Individuals and Small Businesses.

THESE ARTICLES OF MERGER AND PLAN OF MERGER are entered into as of December 14, 2011 by and between SOUTHERN GOOD FAITH FUND, an Arkansas nonprofit corporation (the "SGFF") and SOUTHERN BANCORP CAPITAL PARTNERS, an Arkansas nonprofit corporation ("SBCP").

#### RECITALS

The respective Boards of Directors of SBCP and SGFF have approved the merger of SGFF into SBCP (the "Merger") upon the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein.

It is intended that the Merger shall qualify under Arkansas law and that SBCP be the surviving entity.

## ARTICLE I PARTIES TO THE MERGER/SURVIVING ENTITY

1.1 NAMES OF CORPORATIONS. The name of each entity planning to merge, the jurisdiction of organization of each entity planning to merge, and type of entity are as follows:

SOUTHERN GOOD FAITH FUND, an Arkansas Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation under the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act

SOUTHERN BANCORP CAPITAL PARTNERS, an Arkansas Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation under the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act

1.2 NAME OF THE SURVIVING ENTITY. The name of the surviving entity is SOUTHERN BANCORP CAPITAL PARTNERS (the "Surviving Entity"). The Surviving Entity shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arkansas. The Articles of Incorporation of the Surviving Entity as amended and restated pursuant to Article IV herein shall be the Articles of Incorporation of the Surviving Entity after the Effective Time.

## ARTICLE II TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MERGER

2.1 THE MERGER. At the Effective Time and subject to the terms and conditions of this Articles of Merger and Plan of Merger, SGFF shall be merged into SBCP and the separate existence of SGFF shall thereupon cease in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act of 1993, as amended (the "Act"), and the Merger will have the effects Articles of Merger and Plan of Merger of Southern Good Faith Fund into Southern Bancorp Capital Partners - 1

## AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOUTHERN BANCORP CAPITAL PARTNERS

### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is Southern Bancorp Capital Partners.

## ARTICLE II TYPE OF NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The Corporation is a public benefit corporation.

## ARTICLE III REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The registered office of the Corporation shall be located at 8924 Kanis Road, Little Rock, Arkansas 72205. The name of the registered agent of the Corporation at that address is Tanya Wright.

## ARTICLE IV MEMBERS

The Corporation will not have members.

### ARTICLE V PURPOSE

The nature of the Corporation and its object or purpose carried on by it is exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of sections 170(c)(2)(B), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Corporation shall be empowered —

- A. To transform rural Southern communities by creating new educational and economic opportunities for people with limited resources.
  - B. To conduct any other nonprofit activity that is not inconsistent with law.

### ARTICLE VI POWERS

The Corporation shall have, in furtherance of its foregoing purposes, all of the powers and authority allowed to a nonprofit corporation under the laws of Arkansas subject only to applicable restrictions. In addition to those enumerated powers and authority, the Corporation shall have the power to:

- A. apply for, accept, hold, and administer the principal and income of any gift, donation, grant, devise, or bequest, or any part thereof, in such manner as may have been stipulated or provided in the instrument creating such gift, donation, grant, devise, or bequest.
- B. accept, hold, administer, invest, and disburse such funds and properties of any lawful kind or character as from time to time may be given to it by persons, corporations, or governmental agencies absolutely or in trust, as the case may be; employ and retain proper employees, agents, experts, consultants, accountants, advisors, and investment counselors for the proper accepting, holding, administering, investing, and disbursing of proper funds and properties; and in general to do all things that may appear lawful and necessary and useful in accomplishing these purposes.

Notwithstanding the foregoing powers, the following provisions shall take precedence:

- 1. no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Articles V and VI hereof;
- 2. no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office; and
- 3. the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 4. the Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to subject the Corporation to tax under section 4942 of the Code.
- 5. the Corporation shall not engage in any act of "self-dealing" as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code.
- 6. the Corporation shall not retain any "excess business holdings" as defined in section 4943(c) of the Code.

- 7. The Corporation shall not make any taxable investments within the meaning of section 4944 of the Code.
- 8. The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Code.

### ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs, property, and business of the Corporation shall be managed and controlled by a Board of Directors consisting of the number of Directors determined by the Bylaws, but not less than three Directors nor more than 16. Directors of the Corporation shall be elected and hold office in the manner determined by these Articles and the Bylaws of the Corporation. Directors may be removed, and vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled in the manner provided in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE VIII BYLAWS

The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall make, adopt, alter, amend, and repeal such Bylaws of the Corporation for the conduct of the business of the Corporation and the carrying out of its purposes as the Board of Directors may deem necessary from time to time.

## ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation may be amended by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the entire Board of Directors of the Corporation. The procedure for submitting proposed amendments to the Board of Directors shall be as provided in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE X DEFENSE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless, every registered agent, Director, or officer and his or her heirs, personal representatives, and administrators against liability and against expenses to the fullest extent permitted under Arkansas law.

## ARTICLE XI DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation, the Corporation shall first pay or make provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation. The remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit organization or organizations as the Board of Directors shall determine, as long as each of such organizations shall then qualify as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(a) of the Code, as an organization described in sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code.

Assets not distributed pursuant to the previous paragraph shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located. However, assets shall be distributed exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations described in sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code, as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such charitable or educational purposes. In no event shall any of the Corporation's assets be distributed to any Director, officer, or any private individual.

### ARTICLE XII EFFECTIVE DATE

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation shall become effective at 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2011 (the "Effective Date").


