serving abroad or by pastors or denominational leaders from the nations Ministry Resource Network, Inc serves.

When a project is approved by the Directors, it may be funded from the corporation's general fund or from special

Fourteen Christian workers serving the Evangelical Church of Bosnia Hercegovina receive modest levels of support on a monthly basis
from Ministry Resource Network, Inc. Their support levels are approved by the National Presbytery and the money is provided to members
of the Presbytery for distribution to these 14 individuals. In effect Ministry Resource Network, Inc provides these amounts to the
denomination and the individuals are paid by their own national church.
Dr John Tanksley spends 4 - 6 months annually working in a variety of African hospitals teaching national doctors orthopedic surgical
techniques. Because these hospitals are primitive and lack up to date equipment and supplies, he purchases and donates required
surgical supplies and equipment to facilitate his training and post training surgical procedures.
