



Proposals should be concise yet contain adequate information about the specific project for which funding is sought, and current data on the organization's financial status, management, board of directors, and scope of service to the community. Particular emphasis should be placed on why it would be appropriate for the Foundation to support a given request. The Foundation only provides support for Internal Revenue Code Sec. 501(c)(3) organizations and evidence of Sec. 501(c)(3) status must be submitted. Requests from individuals and organizations other than Sec. 501(c)(3) organizations will not be considered.

The Foundation reviews requests throughout the year. All requests will receive a response from the Foundation within approximately 60 days of the submission of the request.
