Scholarship Rules

Selection Criteria

- ♦ Academic achievement
- ♦ Involvement in extracurricular activities
- ♦ Financial need
- ♦ Correctly completed scholarship application and accompanying information
- ♦ Interview with the Palmetto Youth Center Scholarship Committee

Description of Scholarship Program and Benefits

Each year the Beall's Foundations may select students to receive a scholarship award. The Trustees of the Foundation may award up to \$2,500 (per year) to help fund college education for the first two years and up to \$5,000 for years three and four. The scholarship can be used for room and board, tuition, fees, and books.

Any interested student can request a Scholarship Application Form from the Foundation or from the Palmetto Youth Center. The form must be submitted by the deadline determined by the Palmetto Youth Center to be considered. A decision will be made in April or May.

Eligibility Requirements for a Foundation Scholarship

- ♦ Be formally accepted to a Florida Secondary, two-year or four-year accredited institution

Qualifications for Continuing Eligibility of a Foundation Scholarship

1. Recipients will be at risk of losing the scholarship if they fail to maintain at least a 2.5 (A=4.0) GPA each semester and overall. Demonstrated effort as well as the difficulty of school and major will be considered.
2. Suspension or expulsion will automatically terminate scholarship assistance.
3. Convictions in court of law may terminate scholarship assistance.
4. The student must maintain a full course load (generally 12 hours) as specified by the school recipient is attending.
5. The student must have official transcripts sent directly from the school to Beall's Foundations at the end of each grading period.
6. The student must send a copy of their new class schedule for the next grading period to Beall's Foundations.
7. The student must volunteer at minimum of 10 hours at the Palmetto Youth Center annually. The volunteer hours must be performed during the period August – July of each year. If the student does not fulfill the minimum requirement, they may lose their scholarship funding.
8. The student must attend the Annual Martin Luther King banquet sponsored by the Palmetto Youth Center. The banquet is held in January of each year.
9. The student must attend mandatory Scholarship Retreats that will be held twice a year.
10. During June and December of each year that the student is eligible and wants to continue receiving the scholarship for the next academic year, he or she must complete the scholarship certification form. This form details scholarship eligibility requirements, due dates, and other pertinent information. In addition to completing the form, the following must be attached

- ♦ Official Transcript
- ♦ Class Registration Schedule
- ♦ Financial Aid Award Letter or Summary
- ♦ College Acceptance Letter (new students)

While it is the intent of the Foundations is to continue the funding of qualified recipients for four years, this is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the Foundation and the availability of funds. Additionally, the Palmetto Youth Center Scholarship Committee will evaluate the program annually and may make changes to program at that time.

Mentor Program

The mentor program was designed to provide an opportunity for constructive dialogue and sharing of wisdom that will enhance the student's ability to have a successful college career. Below are guidelines for the program.

- ♦ Each student will be assigned a mentor of the same gender.
- ♦ The mentor and student should meet before and after each grading period. Frequent meetings should help develop a rapport between the student and the mentor. The mentor should discuss the student's class schedule including number of classes the student is taking, grades, etc.
- ♦ The student is required to inform mentor any time there is a schedule or major subject change.
- ♦ Mentors should make a student status report to the board after each grading period.

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Acknowledgment
